

Clarksville Kennel Club Dog Training Class Cancellation Protocol – Weather Related

The safety of our dogs, handlers, instructors, and volunteers is our top priority. If you feel travel conditions are unsafe, please stay home. You will be sent any homework for missed classes.

If Clarksville-Montgomery County Schools are closed for weather, our classes are also cancelled.

Dog training classes may be delayed, cancelled, or rescheduled due to hazardous weather conditions.

- Weather Conditions that may cause cancellation:
 - Snow or ice accumulation
 - Freezing rain or sleet
 - Severe thunderstorms or lightning
 - Extreme heat or cold
 - Flooding or unsafe travel conditions
 - Local or state travel advisories

- Decision Authority
 - Cancellation decisions are made by club leadership and/or the lead instructor
 - Decisions are based on:
 - Local weather forecasts
 - Road conditions
 - Instructor and participant safety
 - Facility safety

- Notification of Cancellation
 - Participants will be notified no later than 12:00 pm (noon) on the day of class
 - Notifications will be sent via:
 - Email
 - Club Facebook Page
 - Club Website

If Clarksville-Montgomery County Schools are closed for weather, our classes are also cancelled.

- Participant Responsibility
 - Participants should always use their own judgment regarding travel safety
 - If you feel that conditions are unsafe in your area, please notify your instructor even if class has not been cancelled (ClarksvilleKennelClub@gmail.com)

- Make-Up Classes
 - Cancelled classes will be rescheduled or added to the end of the current session

- Day-Of Communications
 - If weather conditions change suddenly, last-minute updates will be posted immediately
 - Participants are encouraged to check their email and the club's Facebook and Website before leaving home
