

Week 4 Activation Session— Demonstrating the Kingdom

Jesus demonstrated the Kingdom before commanding His disciples to do the same.

- Tonight is about obedience, not performance.
- We minister under Christ's delegated authority.
- The Holy Spirit supplies the power.

2. Pair Up

- Find a partner.
- Share one simple need if desired.
- Examples: healing, peace, freedom, wisdom, restoration, direction, relationships.
- Keep sharing brief—this is ministry, not counseling.

3. Prepare to Minister

- Represent the King.
- Don't try to convince God.
- Pray in the Spirit if you do so.
- Listen to the Holy Spirit.
- Keep declarations simple.
- Speak directly to the need.

4. Minister with Authority

- Speak healing.
- Speak peace.
- Speak freedom.
- Speak restoration.
- Remain in faith and rest.
- Stay under His authority.
- Authority is delegated; power belongs to the Holy Spirit.

5. Sample Kingdom Declarations

- Be healed in the name of Jesus Christ. (Acts 3:6; Mark 16:17-18)
- Pain, leave now in Jesus' name. (Matthew 10:1,8)
- Healing, be released in Jesus' name. (Acts 3:6)
- Strength, be restored. (Isaiah 40:31)
- Fear, leave now. (1 John 4:18)
- Peace, fill this heart and mind. (Philippians 4:7)

- Freedom, be established. (John 8:36)
- Every chain, be broken. (Isaiah 58:6)
- Life, come forth. (John 11:43)
- Every mountain, be removed. (Mark 11:23)
- The will of God be done here as it is in heaven. (Matthew 6:10)
- Holy Spirit, confirm Your Word with signs following. (Mark 16:20; Hebrews 2:3-4)

6. Continue Ministering

- Don't rush.
- Allow the Holy Spirit to lead.
- If improvement occurs, continue ministering.
- Matthew 8:16 – Jesus cast out spirits with His word and healed the sick.
- Don't become discouraged.
- The King has not changed.
- The Kingdom has not changed.

7. Closing

- Invite testimonies.
- Give Jesus all the glory.
- Walk in faith.
- Walk in confidence.
- Walk in rest.
- Exercise delegated authority.
- Depend on the Holy Spirit.
- Demonstrate the Kingdom wherever you go.
