

Kingdom Purpose (or Mission) — Every kingdom exists to extend the will, influence, culture, and glory of its king. Without this purpose, the other components become static.

In God's Kingdom, this is reflected in man's original mandate to exercise dominion under God (Genesis 1:26–28) and Jesus' commission to make disciples of all nations (Matthew 28:18–20).
