2023 – 2024 School Year Information

Thank you for your interest in Holy Love Preschool and Kindergarten. We begin registration in early February. We begin with our church members, current and former families, and then the community. The following list should help you decide which class best suits your child. The age cut-off for most classes is October 1st. In some cases, we may suggest a trial period of one month in case the teacher or parent decides the child is not academically, emotionally, or socially ready. Our student to adult ratio is 7:1 and 10:1 depending on the classroom. You will find a list of our prices on the back of this page. To register and hold your child's placement you will need the registration fee, cash, or check, made out to Holy Love Preschool.



Preschool AM or PM Tuesday/Thursday: This program is for children 3 years old by October 1, 2023, and potty trained. Both morning (9:15-11:45) and afternoon (12:45-3:15) sessions are offered. Class enrollment is up to 30 children with three teachers and a teacher assistant per session.

- All skills, practice, show & tell activities at table w/ teacher (1-10), ("Hard skills" start in Feb).
- Exposure to Letter of the Week, numbers.
- Every month is a different theme, color, and bible verse.
- Each time the child comes there's opportunity for pre-reading, pre-math, pre-science, free play, snack, recess, puzzles, manipulative, arts/crafts, music and worship every day.



Pre-Kindergarten II/STEAM Tuesday/Thursday: This program is for children 4 years old by October 1, 2023. This class is offered 9:15-3:15, with lunch hour from 11:45-12:45. You provide lunch, snacks, and beverage for your child. Class enrollment is up to 18 children with two teachers. We recommend this class for continuing students and first-time students. Even children who know their ABC's will benefit and be well prepared for kindergarten. This class will incorporate science, pre-technology, engineering, and math. It is a hands-on program, which also includes music, art, and story. This class will enhance your child's everyday experiences. Your child will practice their expanding listening skills, gross motor, fine motor, and cognitive skills.

- Pre-K begins with "Handwriting Without Tears" workbooks.
- Math, Language Arts and Science begin in November.



Pre-Kindergarten AM or PM Monday/Wednesday/Friday: This program is for children 4 years old by October 1, 2023. Monday/Wednesday/Friday class offers both morning (9:15-11:45) and afternoon (12:45-3:15) sessions. Class enrollment is up to 30 children with three teachers and a teacher assistant per session. We recommend Pre-K for continuing students and first-time students. Even children who know their ABC's will benefit and be well prepared for kindergarten.

- Pre-K begins with "Handwriting Without Tears" workbooks.
- Math, Language Arts and Science begin in November.



Jr. Kindergarten Monday – Friday, 5 AM or 5 PM Classes: This program is for children who are 5 years old by March 1, 2024. Children must meet the age criteria for this class. This class is offered 9:15-11:45 a.m. *or* 12:45-3:15 p.m. Class enrollment is 14 children with two teachers. Jr.K is for children who don't meet the state age cutoff for kindergarten (October 1st) or who are close to the cutoff but not quite ready for the big step to kindergarten. The class is filled with positive social interactions due to the small size and the consistency of the five-day half-day schedule.

-All Jr. K classes use "Handwriting Without Tears" workbooks and for math, My Numbers Through 20 Journal by Really Good Stuff along with Purposeful Design Math.

-All Jr. K classes work with kindergarten level material.



Kindergarten Full-Day Monday/Wednesday/Friday: This program is for children 5 years old by October 1, 2023. This class is offered 9:15-3:15. Although this Kindergarten program is designed to meet the needs of those children who will be 5 by the public-school October 1st cutoff date, we suggest a trial period of one month in case the teacher or parent decides the child is not emotionally or socially ready for a Kindergarten experience. Please note that entry into *first grade* in public school the following year still requires that your child meet the October 1st cutoff date or placement testing may be necessary for entry. Our Kindergarten class enrollment maximum is 20 children with two elementary qualified teachers. All Kindergarten students will meet or exceed the Cherry Creek Kindergarten standards. We utilize BJU Press Math curriculum, A Beka for developing handwriting, and for literacy we use a variety of curriculum for small and large groups including Butterfly Park (different learning styles).

- All families pay an \$80.00 non-refundable registration fee per class.
- Siblings pay \$40.00 a non-refundable registration fee per class.
- Preschool and Pre-K MWF students pay a \$100.00 supply fee per class (one time only per year).
- Pre-K II/Pre-STEAM and Jr. K M-F students pay a \$120.00 supply fee (one time only per year).
- Kindergarten pays a \$120.00 book fee (one time only per year); No supply fee. Parents bring supplies.
- Each child will receive one memory book from their teacher at year end.
- Holy Love Lutheran Church families receive a 10% discount on monthly tuition.
- Families with multiple children enrolled receive a 10% discount off monthly tuition for the second child.
- Fees may be subject to change and advance notification would be made if necessary.

Tuition is due by the 10th of each month!
