- 5. Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes
  - a. **A motion to approve March 2025 Council Minutes** was made by Pastor Brittany, seconded by Ed Truett. **The motion was carried unanimously.**
- 6. Committee/Task Force Reports
  - a. Pastor's Report (Pastor Brittany)
    - Good feedback about Lent midweeks Council did not believe there needed to be a formal survey. Considering having HL host next year (still with alternating responsibilities)
    - ii. Parking lot capital campaign has started and will be announced again at Easter. Also looking for spot sponsors (not assigned spots).
    - iii. Addressed confusion regarding UPK PBK is going to gather a forum of churches that have preschools to communicate together; this is in response to potential impact of funding cuts to private preschools.
  - b. Property (Ed Truett)
    - Another incident of mailbox vandalism 3/21 Saturday mail deliveries have been discontinued by USPS. Lindy requested an update when mailbox has been checked to avoid redundant efforts.
    - ii. New hot water heater will be installed soon off of the Council room.
    - iii. Church Office Furniture moves ongoing, but PBK enjoying the new configuration.

The Saturday usage would be a 7-hour time block, and there would be a formalized space-sharing agreement. Recommended a \$500 fee per Saturday as well as additional direction regarding cleaning/set-up. Carol recommended reaching out to the church that they currently rent from as a reference.
