 - While great, it was also very tiring. Unclear on how much of this is normal and how much of it is the fatigue of group gatherings in a Covid world
 - o I'm curious about the feasibility of offering something like this (not full day, and not all week) during winter and spring breaks from school. That was my goal with the Break Out Sessions. **Council's thoughts?**
- Confirmation Camp Follow-Up:
 - o 3 kids, very fun and also tiring
 - Strong connection to RTLC

 - Folks from the 3 pm service would attend the 9:30 am service as they are able with work schedules on Sundays when the 3 pm service isn't running
 - People are welcome at BOTH services! Always!!!
 - Pastor Hesron would still have some formal leadership role, but the Pastor of Holy Love [currently me] would be primarily responsible for all pastoral needs
 - Pastor Hesron is ordained in a Lutheran denomination that does not have bilateral relations with the ELCA
 - Bishop Gonia is working on writing a proposal and notes from the meeting. That will be shared as soon as it's available
 - This will still come before the congregation for a formal vote and meeting
- I'm co-authoring a fiction book about three clergy women in a rural, American Western town, set for May 2023 publishing date
 - This is something I'm doing in my own time for personal fun
 - O Was on a writing retreat 7/11-7/15 for it
 - I am not looking to leave congregational ministry. This is a side project, an outside activity. I am not looking to get famous or wealthy off this either
 - o No, you are not going to be a fictional character in the book. Sorry, friends!
