

Council Highlights-June 21, 2022

Holy Love's Church council met on June 21, 2022. Some highlights from that meeting:

1. The initiative to pursue a relationship with the Indonesian church is ongoing. We had a productive meeting with their leadership, though subsequently questions about their long-term plans have necessitated further conversation between them and Holy Love and the Synod. Further reports based on these additional conversations will be discussed with council.
2. All Stars is progressing. The insurance component is still outstanding. Holy Love, per the Facility Usage Document, will ask to be named an additional insured.
3. On the third Monday of the month, in order to accommodate All Star, will meet elsewhere in the church. The first suggestion was the Sanctuary, but this presented a number of problems. (Subsequent to the council meeting, it was determined that the youth room would be the better option for NA.)
4. No changes to Worship Protocols were authorized.
5. The cement work and landscaping on the west side of the church is progressing.
6. Darryl Harvey passed on a suggestion that real candles be replaced with LED candles. Real candles drip wax on the pews, which are very difficult to clean. Also, the open flame present a fire hazard. We have enough people prepared to donate the money to buy the LEDs. Some argued that they preferred the real candles and other like the symbolism of the passing of the flame from one person to the next. The matter was referred to Worship and Music for their input.
