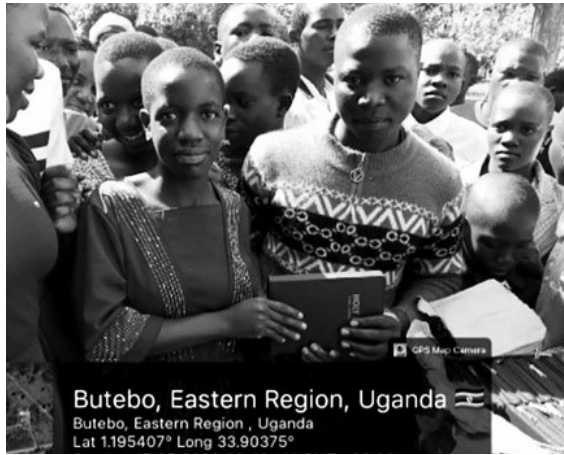
From Mukisa Enoch in Uganda

We have been receiving testimonies from Mukisa Enoch in Uganda regarding great deliverance received by students of New Life in Christ including physical healing as well as outreach. Here are some examples:

It looks like an amazing week! Indeed I'm very happy to hear good news from our class in St. Johnathan. Yesterday the youth moved all over the community preaching the gospel to people. They found 10 youths in the bar and preached to them, and they accepted Christ. What amazed me, is that they visited the home of a witch doctor, preached to him the gospel, and he accepted Christ. After this encounter, they burnt the shrine and he is now fully saved! These youth told me that every Monday, Tuesday and Sunday evenings, they visit communities and local centers to minister.

Since I've been so pleased with their good news, they have requested me to come and visit them on Sunday, and share their joy together with these people who recently got saved from the evil in their lives. I have been asked by them to come and bless them on Sunday.

The class leader has requested us to help them with some 40 Bibles. There are 49 students who are taking God's Rescue & Restoration Plan (GRRP) teachings, and they all completed New Life In Christ (NLIC) teachings, and are on session 2 of GRRP presently.

Today, I received news about a 12-year-old boy with blindness in one eye who joined the NLIC teachings at the Canaan class, which had requested bibles from us. I often saw him when I visited the class. At first, he came only to listen during the lessons, but after about a month, he decided to join.

This is now his fourth month as a student in the class. During this time, he learned how to pray and became very strong in prayer. Today, during the class lesson, God gave him a wonderful blessing: the eye that had been blind began to see. Everyone is filled with joy and gratitude. His parents searched for my contact and called me, singing, "Hallelujah, hallelujah." The boy is very happy, and the whole community is celebrating this wonderful testimony.

Teaching the Bible in Schools

We had a session with our young people on Friday May 29th. This was a bit different from the previous sessions due to the portable rechargeable radios that were funded by LiveCharis. The day was extraordinary for the learners, who were dressed in African attire as per the school program. They danced the cartoon songs about following Jesus without turning back. They are also participating in reading the passages of the lesson being taught.

What touched my heart was their hunger to know the truth about resurrection which is an interesting thing especially to the young people. They asked questions about going to heaven and what it looks like. This made me take my time teaching them the truth about the Word of God, and unfolding the events in short, as to how these things will happen.

I appreciate the teachings on LiveCharis platforms, for they equipped us, to help the young people get the right information about the Word of God. Though the laptop screen was too small, they danced, imitating the moves done on the screen while the speakers were connected. This made our lessons more impactful.

From Isaac and Caroline Dube in Zimbabwe

Dobolo Village is one of the remote villages that Isaac and Caroline Dube regularly visit to bring the Gospel. Very few people in that village speak or read English. Isaac reached out to LiveCharis with a request to supply native language Bibles. On Pentecost weekend, May 23-24, Isaac delivered the Bibles, 32 in Tonga and 7 in Ndebele. The people of Dobolo Village were overjoyed to have Bibles that they could read!

The following weekend Isaac took Bibles to Kwalala Village. The people danced and sang, holding their new Bibles in the air. The Bible teaches us in Matthew 4:4 that, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." What a blessing for LiveCharis to be able to provide the Bibles!
