Tee Shirt Prep & Instructions

- Please be sure shirts are freshly laundered, don't use fabric softener or dryer sheets and are free from pet hair.
- Please **DO NOT** cut the shirts
- You may want to avoid clothing with stains or holes in the design area as they will still be there when the quilt is done.
- You are able to use the front and back of a shirt, pocket and sleeve designs as well.
- Put an "X" in painters tape (Masking tape leaves residue) on any designs you **DO NOT** want included.
- You can add a note to 4-5 shirts as favorites to ensure they are used as main shirts in the quilt.
- If you want a specific layout feel free to lay them out and e-mail me a photo.
- If you have more shirts than may be needed, place them in a separate bag labeled "EXTRA", they will be used only if needed.
