RVR History Trail

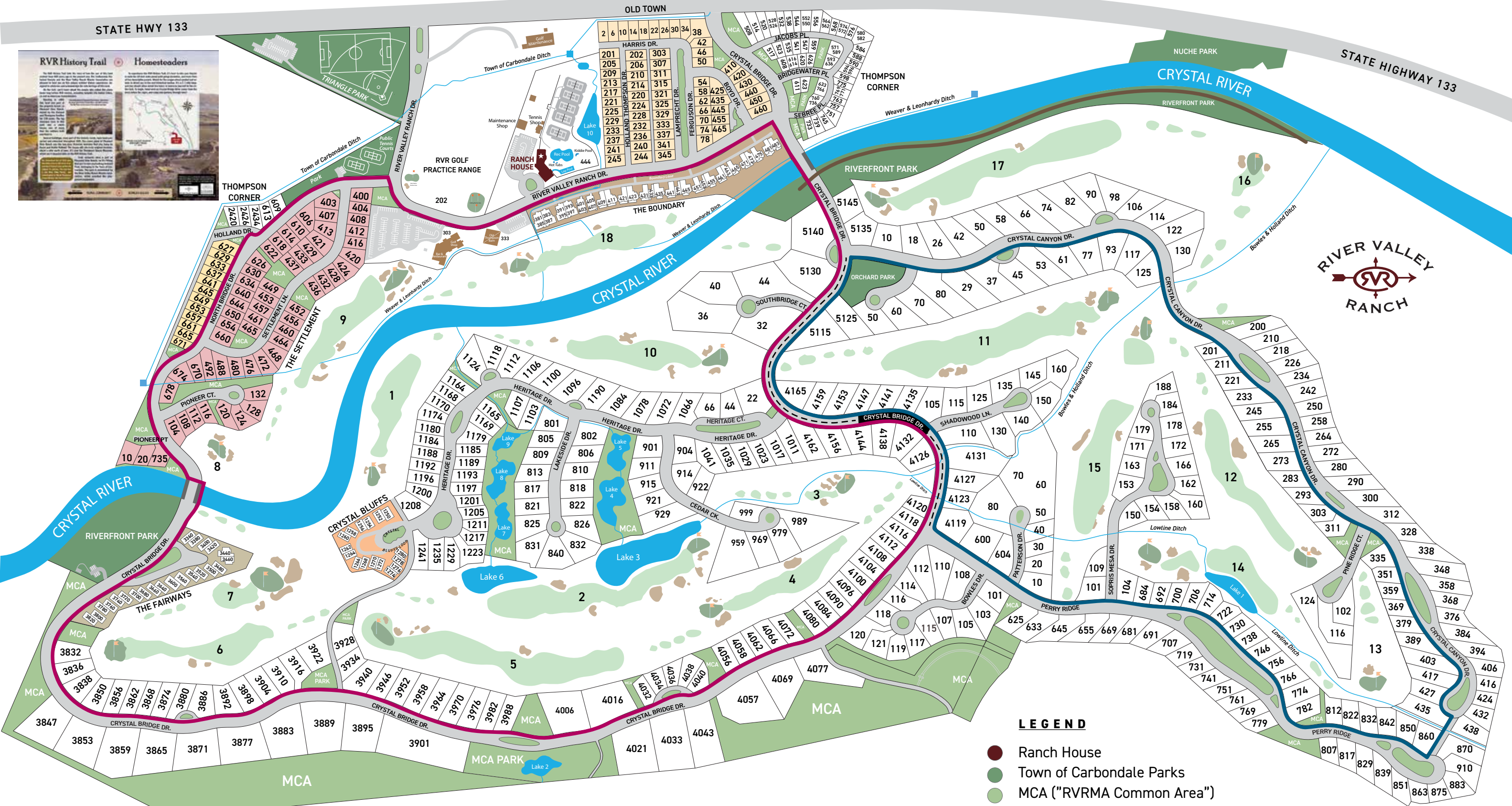
The RVR History Trail is a 2.7-mile loop that winds through the heart of the River Valley Ranch community. It is a multi-use path that is suitable for walking, jogging, and biking. The trail is located along the Crystal River and is bordered by the Town of Carbondale Parks and the MCA (River Valley Ranch Management Area).

The trail is a loop that starts at the Ranch House, goes south on River Valley Ranch Dr., then west on Crystal Bridge Dr., then north on Crystal Canyon Dr., and finally east on Crystal Bridge Dr. back to the Ranch House.

Homesteaders

The Homesteaders are the original settlers of the River Valley Ranch community. They were pioneers who came to the area in the late 19th century and established the ranch. The Homesteaders were a hardworking and determined group of people who built the ranch into a thriving community.
