Virtue in Christ, a 501(c)3 federally tax exempt corporation registered in the State of Maryland, was established in 2011 as a vehicle for women's Christian training and spiritual fortification. Since 2012, this Christian education vehicle has catered to the needs of the women and girls within and outside of the Body of Christ.

Virtue in Christ trains women and girls in Christian character by developing and facilitating curricula for the Ladies of Virtue retreats and mentorship programs. Our professional meeting and event planners and credentialed project managers coordinate, promote, and evaluate all of our programming so we can better understand lessons learned and implement best practices in the future.

Virtue in Christ administers every aspect of the retreat/event web pages, uses social media (including Facebook, Twitter/X, Instagram, and mass email marketing) to communicate with stakeholders, manage event registration, and publish print and electronic collateral associated with our programming.

Reach

Although primarily serving the mid-Atlantic region, Virtue in Christ crosses state, regional, and national boundaries, with thousands of supporters and beneficiaries from Florida to Maine, from California to Washington DC, and from the US to the UK. To reach them, we use mass email distribution, social media (Facebook, Instagram, and Twitter), and direct mail.

Services Summary



Our flagship programs are the Annual Ladies of Virtue Retreat and the True Beauty and Virtue Mentoring Program.

Annual Ladies of Virtue Retreat

The Ladies of Virtue Retreat is a weekend-long respite, a time of sisterly fellowship and Christian edification that attracts women and girls from all over the United States.

In 2011, we partnered with the Aberdeen Church of Christ in Aberdeen MD, to produce the first Virtue in an Age of Promiscuity ladies retreat. This partnership continued through 2015 with Aberdeen Church of Christ as the sponsor for the retreat. From 2016 to 2019, the Ladies of Virtue retreat operated as an educational component and ministry of the Northeast Baltimore Bible Institute & College (NBBIC), and in 2019, the 13th Street Church of Christ in Washington DC sponsored the retreat.

Since 2020, the Church of Christ in Sandtown, Baltimore MD, has been the host and sponsor.

True Beauty and Virtue Mentoring Program

In 2017, Virtue in Christ began working year-round with teenaged girls in the West Baltimore community of Sandtown-Winchester to help them cultivate positive Christian character traits, and encourage their work in the community and in the church. Now on a regional level, Virtue in Christ has stepped in to provide mentoring and leadership training in the mid-Atlantic. This work is complementary to the work already being done by community partners and the Church of Christ in Sandtown.

Services Summary



The True Beauty and Virtue Mentorship (TBVM) Program is a vehicle for mentoring young ladies, founded on Christian principles, and designed to imbue participants with decorum, self-respect, integrity, and Christian accountability in all situations. The program is designed to help ladies as young as 5 years of age maneuver life's challenges by building self-esteem, self-efficacy for good behavior, and personal refinement through the advancement of Christian principles and personal development.

Through our mentorship, participants will achieve the following outcomes:

- Development and exhibition of an esteemed sense of self
- Development of self-efficacy for personal motivation
- Development of self-efficacy for servant leadership behaviors
- Development and exhibition personal responsibility traits
- Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of Christian value
- Dedication to continued self-reflection

Volunteer mentors are paired with young ladies and will spend a year role modeling Christian principles, enjoying virtual or in-person fellowship, giving advice, and discussing issues important to the young women, especially as it pertains to obedience to Christ.

Fundraising

To support the charitable purposes of Virtue in Christ, we administer the Infinity by Virtue fundraiser and we are listed as a charity supported through the Combined Federal Campaign.

Infinity by Virtue is the signature fundraiser for Virtue in Christ. The proceeds from the sale of handmade bracelet, earrings, necklaces and more support the organization's mission to edify and mentor girls and young women.
