The Fort Huachuca Community Spouses' Club (FHCSC) will award scholarships to students who are graduating from high school and attending their freshman year of college in the 2022-2023 academic year. Eligible applicants are the dependent children of U.S. military (active duty, reserve component, National Guard, retired or deceased) or DOD civilians (active, retired, or deceased) whose sponsor is assigned to or living in the greater Fort Huachuca area. Students of FHCSC members (as of 6 March 2022) regardless of military affiliation are also eligible. Students may have already earned some college credit.

To be considered for the FHCSC High School scholarship, you must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 over the last two years of high school and have demonstrated outstanding citizenship. Applicants who do not meet the scholarship criteria will not be considered.

All applicants will be notified of the results no later than 30 April 2022. Scholarship recipients will be recognized at a reception in May. The date of the reception will be communicated at the time of winning notification.

Scholarship monies are for the payment of tuition, fees, books, room and board and are paid directly to the school. If the scholarship monies are not used for these fees before 1 October 2022, you will lose eligibility for a monetary award and the monies will be returned to the FHCSC Scholarship Fund.
