A Warm Welcome

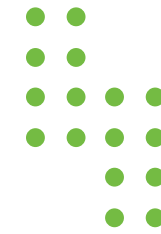

ACADEMIC INSIGHTS

Administrative and academic office spaces typically make up the largest non-residential space on a campus: 19% of total space, according to the Society of College and University Planning (SCUP) Campus Facilities Inventory. These spaces should allow for dedicated individual work to prep for class, 1:1 student conversations and then allow for collaboration with other faculty members throughout the day.
