



MAKE-UP & HAIR REQUIREMENTS FOR PICTURE DAY & RECITAL

Hair

All female dancers must wear their hair in a neat bun at the crown of the head. Use bobby pins or dance pins, strong gel, hairspray, and a hairnet to secure the style.

Hair supplies are available at Pizzazz Dancewear & Supplies. A bun tutorial video is available on the studio's Facebook page.

Make-Up

Makeup is required because stage lighting can wash out facial features.

- **Petite Ballerina and Baby Take a Bow** dancers should wear light blush and pink lipstick. **Kitty Kat Rock** dancers should wear whiskers and a cat nose made with eyeliner, along with red lipstick.
- **Garnet level** dancers (Rainbow, Rainbow, Dancing in the Dark, I Want you Back): should wear tan eyeshadow, blush, mascara, and red lipstick.
- **All other dancers** must wear tan eyeshadow, blush, eyeliner, mascara, and red lipstick. Red lipstick is required.
- **Older dancers** should apply makeup over foundation and finish with powder to prevent shine. A photo example is available on the studio bulletin board.

Important Information

- Bring extra hair supplies and makeup for touch-ups. Costumes should be stored in a labeled garment bag or covered hanger.
- All costumes, shoes, tights, accessories, and makeup should be prepared ahead of time.
- Only water is allowed backstage. Food and drinks are not permitted.
- Pack quiet activities such as coloring books or crafts. Markers are not allowed.
- Dancers **may not wear underwear or bras** under costumes. If you feel that your child needs to wear an undergarment, over and under's are available in the store and they are the only undergarment permitted.
- **Nail polish is not permitted.**
