Drop-off and Pickup Procedures for Garnet Level and Up

A female parent or legal guardian must bring their child to the assigned dressing room door 30 minutes prior to curtain. At this time your child will be placed under the supervision of their room mom. You will receive a wristband. Please attach it around your wrist and find a seat in the auditorium with your friends and family. At intermission you must show this wristband to the security guards to gain access to the dressing room area. At the conclusion of the recital, you must show the wristband to the security guard when picking up your child. NO MEN ARE PERMITTED IN THE DRESSING ROOMS.

Drop-off and Pickup Procedures Kitty Kat Rock and Ballet Star Families

Your dancer will be sitting in the auditorium with their family during Act I. A wristband has been included in this handbook and the dancer must be wearing the wristband to gain entry into the auditorium. At the beginning of intermission all Kitty Kat Rock and Ballet Star Dancers MUST be brought to the assigned dressing room by a female parent or legal guardian. At this time your child will be placed under the supervision of their room mom. The female parent or legal guardian will receive a wristband. It must be attached around the wrist and at this time please find a seat in the auditorium with your friends and family. At the conclusion of the recital, you must show the wristband to the security guard when picking up your child. NO MEN ARE PERMITTED IN THE DRESSING ROOMS.

Costumes, Makeup, and Hair

Make sure that you have all costumes, accessories, and shoes. Follow hair and makeup guidelines. These guidelines are in this handbook. It is essential that you follow the makeup guidelines because if you don't no one will be able to see the clarity of your child's face onstage.

Backstage and Dressing Room Areas

Family members and friends do not belong backstage or in the dressing room during the recital. The same applies during intermission and after the show.

Please remind your guests that there is a lot of backstage activity in a limited space, and dressing rooms are a private area. Those who wish to greet your child may do so after the show when the curtain has been reopened.

At intermission those with the wristband may go into the dressing room to check on their child. This is only at intermission time.

For the safety of your child room mothers will be supervising your child during the entire length of the show. A security guard will also be present to maintain safety for your child.

FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEOTAPING is absolutely prohibited during the recital. Please instruct your family and friends to leave their video cameras at home on recital day. Our recital is professionally video taped with a quality far superior to what you will get on a home camera shooting between heads in the audience. Aside from the quality difference, video taping and using flash photography is rude and inconsiderate of those around you in the auditorium.

ALSO, NO CELL PHONE RECORDING. There have been times that show guests used cell phones to video. This is inconsiderate of the other guests and this was inconsiderate to those who purchased the DVD because it was visible throughout the DVD during the entire length of the show.

Theater Rules

No eating, drinking or smoking is allowed in the auditorium. We ask that you please be respectful of the dancers on the stage and their parents sitting around you by not getting up and down from your seat during a performance. Everyone would like to see his or her child perform. It is disrespectful to the dancers, their families, and friends to get up from your seat while there is a performance onstage. Please be courteous and wait until the dance is over - or during applause to move from your seat. There will be someone standing at the entrance to the auditorium assisting those entering or exiting the auditorium. Doors will remain closed while a dance is being performed. Cell phones as well as other electronic devices must be turned off or placed on silent mode while you are in the theater. If you have a baby or a toddler, we ask that you pick seats that are towards the rear of the auditorium so that if you need to step into the lobby with them, you will not disturb the entire audience.

Intermission

There will be a 15-minute intermission. At this time, you may purchase 50/50 tickets, flowers, use the restroom, purchase a concession, and/or purchase a bottle of water. If you decide to purchase a bottle of water and/or a concession please drink and eat in the lobby and discard your bottle in the proper container before entering the theater.

Please remember that dancers are not permitted to leave until the recital & finale has concluded.
