## **DANCER DROP-OFF & PICKUP PROCEDURES**

For **Kitty Kat Rock, Baby Take a Bow, and Petite Ballerina classes**, your child will sit in the audience with your family during Act I, and a ticket is required for entry at no cost, so please include your dancer in your ticket count.

At the start of intermission, a female parent or legal guardian must bring the dancer to the assigned dressing room, where they will be placed under the supervision of their Room Mom. At that time, you will receive a wristband or sticker, which must be worn before returning to your seat. At the end of the recital, you must present your wristband or sticker to pick up your child.

For **Garnet level dancers and up**, a female parent or legal guardian must bring the dancer to the assigned dressing room at arrival time. The dancer will remain under the supervision of their Room Mom, and you will receive a wristband or sticker to wear during the recital. During intermission, you may only enter the dressing room area by showing your wristband or sticker to security. At the conclusion of the recital, you must present your wristband or sticker when picking up your child. Please note that no men are permitted in the dressing rooms.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Dancers must arrive fully prepared with costumes, shoes, and accessories. Hair and makeup must follow studio guidelines so faces are visible on stage.

Family members are not permitted backstage or in dressing rooms. Dancers are supervised by Room Moms and security at all times. You may greet your child after the show once the curtain reopens.

Photography and video recording, including cell phones, are not allowed. The performance will be professionally recorded for your convenience.

## **THEATER GUIDELINES**

Food, drinks, and smoking are not permitted in the auditorium. Guests are asked to remain seated during performances and only move during applause or between dances. Auditorium doors will remain closed during performances, and an attendant will assist with entry and exit. All electronic devices must be silenced. Families with small children are encouraged to sit near the back to minimize disruptions.

## **INTERMISSION**

There will be a 20-minute intermission during the recital. During this time, guests may use the restroom and purchase flowers, concessions, and/or 50/50 tickets. Dancers must remain until the recital and finale have concluded.
