- B. Technical Committee – Digital Voice Repeaters in the 435-450 MHz Spectrum
Investigation of the requested interleave of frequencies by the digital operators in the UHF spectrum have the following results.
 - Repeaters (digital) not to occupy more than 12.5 kcs
 - Center frequency of the digital carrier to be offset in steps of 12 kcs which will place these channels in between the 25 kc spaced analog channel groupings
 - 12.5 kc allocations to be digital mode only
 - Maximum transmit power limited to 50 watts
 - Minimum adjacent channel spacing to be extended to 45 miles (72 km) for 35 miles (56 km)
 - Digital users are to be considered secondary users; any interference to analogue repeater operation will have to be corrected by the digital user

Interference Complaints

IC-2006-001	W2DXA – 147.390 – station is experiencing co-channel interference by an uncoordinated repeater run by the Portuguese ARC on the same frequency within the 100 mile limit.	Since WNYSORC is not a regulatory body we have advised W2DXA to file a complaint with both the FCC and IC should the problem not be resolved amicably.
IC-2006-002	VE3WAS – 146.610 – station is being interfered with by an uncoordinated repeater on 146.620 operated by VE3TVG. 146.620 is not a standard repeater frequency.	Since WNYSORC is not a regulatory body we have advised VE3WAS to file a complaint with IC should the problem not be resolved amicably. VE3TVG took repeater off the air.
