Portable Gas Power Generator Use and Safety

ADOPTED 26 March 2020

Public Safety Power Shutoffs are anticipated to continue occurring sporadically into the future. Some homeowners are considering or using portable, gas-powered generators during these shut-offs. While these provide some power relief, they can also be dangerous and must be used with caution. These guidelines are intended to help homeowners operate portable generators in a safe manor and insure the safety of both the homeowner and the Community.

REGISTRATION REQUIRED

Gas-operated portable generators are allowed in the Highlands during a Shutoff. *Prior to use of any generator*, it must be registered with the Association by completing and submitting this form.
