

The centre boasts five fully equipped studios with heating, air conditioning, and full-length mirrors, providing a comfortable and professional environment for all our classes. We're proud to have our own 120-seat studio theatre, where students regularly perform in our in-house productions.

The building also features a disabled lift, a dedicated props and costume department, a vibrant arts and crafts studio, and is home to ROM Theatre Arts College. With two administrative offices, a self-tape studio, self-study rooms, and free parking, our venue is designed to inspire creativity and support young performers at every stage of their journey.
