April 2021 Roadway Update

Last year, repairs on April Cove Road ate up all our roadway budget and we were unable to do planned repairs to roads like Tall Oaks and others that need attention. Unfortunately, due to an unusually high volume of truck traffic on April Cove Road this year, it is in poor shape again. Current estimate is that it will take most of our 2021 road budget to repair April Cove Road. We are working to find a solution that is fair to all. The board will propose at the Annual Meeting to form a Maintenance Committee whose main charge will be deciding what is the best course of action on fixing our roads. Dumpster Help!
