## **Unfinished Business:**

<u>Truck Bid</u>-Commissioner Graff said Supervisor Licari sent an email to the Board and said the Bid from Devino Used Trucks and Parts is acceptable.

**MOTION** 

On Motion by Commissioner Hemsley and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to sell two 2002 Peterbilt trucks to Devino Used Trucks and Parts for \$7,188.00 each. Commissioner Mannone opposed. Commissioners Graff, Doherty, Samoles and Hemsley approved. Motion passed.

Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program (NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program)-Commissioner Graff said the the new roof will be completed by the end of May.

<u>Eastern Environmental</u>-Commissioner Graff said there has been a conversation with their attorney and the Board will discuss the matter in Executive Session.

Code of Ethics-Tabled

Solar Panels-Commissioner Graff said the District is looking into this.

<u>2020 Election</u>- Commissioner Graff said by order of Governor Cuomo the General Election has been postponed until September 15, 2020.

NYS Paid Family Leave-Tabled to discuss with Counsel.

Inter-Municipal Agreement- Tabled

### New Business:

<u>Maintenance Helper</u>- Commissioner Samoles said he nominates Nick Gorina for the position.

**MOTION** 

On Motion by Commissioner Samoles and seconded by Commissioner Hemsley to hire Nick Gorina as a Maintenance Helper. Commissioner Graff opposed. Commissioners Mannone, Doherty, Samoles and Hemsley approved. Motion passed.

<u>Local 553 and CSEA</u>- Commissioner Graff said the Board is amending agreements to grant compensation for working during COVID-19.

**MOTION** 

On Motion by Commissioner Hemsley and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to amend the agreement with Local 553 in order to grant \$3,000.00 for full time workers and \$1,500.00 for part time workers in recognition of their work during the COVID-19 pandemic. Unanimously approved.

Commissioner Graff said that CSEA needs to execute the agreement and that Shop Steward Jay Tavalaro and Les Eason are in agreement with the amendment.

#### **MOTION**

On Motion by Commissioner Samoles and seconded by Commissioner Hemsley to amend the agreement with CSEA in order to grant \$3,000.00 for full time workers in recognition of their work during the COVID-19 pandemic. Unanimously approved.

Commissioner Graff stated he received a memo from Rynkar, Vail & Barrett regarding the transfer of funds for the amendments to the union contracts.

#### **MOTION**

On Motion by Commissioner Doherty and seconded by Commissioner Samoles to transfer \$200,000.00 from the District's Assigned Building Reserve Fund to the Unassigned Fund Balance for the COVID-19 compensation, as well as \$24,500 in additional COVID related expenses. Unanimously approved.

Recycling Pick-Up-Commissioner Graff said he received a proposal sent by the CSEA Supervisors that included returning the week of May 18, 2020 with a 6:00 a.m. start and a 5 day schedule. Vacations can be resumed. It also said seniority would be in place and that no member of Local 553 will enter the office. The Supervisors also recommended that only the driver and one loader go to the dump and a split schedule remains for CSEA.

Commissioner Graff said the blue bins will not get picked up unless it is in a bag within the bin. Commissioner Doherty said it is a health issue for the Sanitation Workers. He said it is only two percent of the residents complaining on Facebook and that the District should mandate that recyclables are in sealed plastic bags. He said bottles and cans have saliva and Corona Virus is air borne.

Commissioner Graff and Commissioner Doherty both said that Local 553 workers will be told not to pick up any recyclables not placed in a sealed bag. Commissioner Doherty said the District may receive many calls and that Facebook is not the place to post the information. Commissioner Graff said the District can send out a robo-call.

#### **MOTION**

On Motion by Commissioner Doherty and seconded by Commissioner Samoles to adopt CSEA's plan modified to include that recycling be placed in bags inside the blue bins in order to be picked up. Unanimously approved.

Commissioner Doherty recommended the office staff keep track of the number of phone calls regarding this Motion.

Public Comment Period: None.

**MOTION** 

On Motion by Commissioner Samoles and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to enter into Executive Session. Unanimously approved.

EXECUTIVE Board went into Executive Session at 6:51 p.m. to discuss matters

**SESSION** 

involving personnel, pending litigation and for the purpose of soliciting

and receiving legal advice.

Commissioner Hemsley left the meeting at 8:15 p.m.

**MOTION** 

On Motion by Commissioner Mannone and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to exit Executive Session at 8:20 p.m. Unanimously approved.

The next General Board of Commissioners Meeting will be held on Thursday, June 4, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.
