Unfinished Business:

Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Program (NY Rising Community Reconstruction Program)-Commissioner Graff said the capping on the roof still needs to be completed and they are working on the HVAC units. The doors are postponed due to the factory being closed during the pandemic.

<u>2020 Election</u>- Commissioner Graff said by order of Governor Cuomo the General Election will be held on September 15, 2020. The Resolutions for the Election will be completed at the July General Meeting.

NYS Paid Family Leave-Tabled to discuss with Counsel.

Inter-Municipal Agreement- Tabled

New Business:

Recycling-Commissioner Graff said recycling resumes the week of June 8th and Local 553 will be at full time and will have a full staff. Commissioner Samoles said the men should be allowed to take the recyclables in anything residents put out including bags and bins.

Commissioner Graff said the Town of Hempstead asked the District to stop picking up recycling with bags. Commissioner Samoles did not agree and said the bags get crushed. Commissioner Doherty questioned what would happen if the bags that people have been storing during the Corona Virus are picked up. Commissioner Samoles said the dump would just give a warning.

Commissioner Doherty suggested that the men pick everything up the first week, June 10th and 11th, and then address the bag issue. Commissioner Mannone said when the committee works on the budget for 2021 the recycling pails should be looked into. Commissioner Doherty stated the cost is approximately \$21.00 per pail.

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Samoles and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to accept any recycling put out by residents on June 10, 2020 and June 11, 2020. Unanimously approved.

Buy Backs:

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Samoles and seconded by Commissioner Mannone to approve a buyback of 15 Days Owed, 3 Personal Days and 66 Sick Days for Michael Bozymowski, to be taxed as a regular paycheck and paid in a lump sum. Unanimously approved.

<u>E-Cycling Program</u>: Commissioner Graff said the April program was canceled due to COVID-19. Nassau County Police Department is available on July 11th to collect medications.

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Hemsley and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to hold the E-Cycling, Shed the Meds and document shredding program for July 11, 2020. Unanimously approved.

<u>FEMA</u>- Commissioner Graff stated the District has between \$15,000 and \$17,000 in additional costs related to COVID-19. He said he will work with Treasurer Lazansky and accountant Alicia Zabala to get the money reimbursed.

<u>Food Drive</u>: Commissioner Samoles suggested having a food drive on June 6th from 12:00-5:00 p.m. to help residents that are not working due to COVID-19. He said WBAB, Newsday and Channel 12 News will advertise the drive.

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Mannone and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to approve the Food Drive to be held on June 6, 2020 from 12:00 p.m-5:00 p.m. Unanimously approved.

Open Meeting Law: Commissioner Mannone expressed his concern regarding how the Board is texting during COVID-19. He said he understands if there is an emergency and to keep the District operating, but he said the Board should not be communicating outside of public meetings. He asked the chairman to use this communication sparingly.

Commissioner Mannone said when three commissioners are conducting regular business it needs to be open to the public. He said the Board should aim to be in compliance with the Open Meeting Law. Commissioner Graff said he will not communicate to the Board as a group. He said he will make sure he phones, emails or texts one on one.

Commissioner Samoles stated he would like to limit the number of questions a resident can ask at a meeting to one. Commissioner Graff said the Board should look at the rules that are in place and then they can be

revised. Commissioners Mannone and Samoles stated chaos is created intentionally. Commissioner Mannone said the Board does not need to take questions.

Commissioner Hemsley and Samoles said that the Board has to take questions from the residents. Commissioner Mannone stated that a specific individual should not be allowed to ask a question. He said he has done harm to the community and that that is factual, not subjective. Commissioner Doherty said the public has a right to ask questions.
