By-Laws: Commissioner Mannone said there have been several changes to the By-Laws in the last year and they need to be updates. Commissioner Graff said he would ask the Office Staff to review and update the By-Laws.

Code of Ethics: Commissioner Graff stated the new committee was just formed.

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Mannone and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to table the Code of Ethics until the next General Meeting where the Committee will set a date to meet. Unanimously approved.

<u>Financial Statements</u>: Commissioner Graff said the Board received and reviewed the 2019 Financial Statements.

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Mannone and seconded by Commissioner Samoles to adopt the 2019 Financial Statements. Unanimously approved.

Buy-Backs-The Board received two requests for Buy-Backs

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Hemsley and seconded by Commissioner Samoles to approve an emergency Buy-Back for Sanitation Worker Jose Hernandez consisting of 6 Compensatory Days, 1 Personal Day, 20 Sick Days and 5 Vacation Days to be paid in a lump sum. Unanimously approved.

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Mannone and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to approve the Buy-Back of 20 Sick Days for Sanitation Worker Theodore Freudenberg subject to verification of the number of days and clarification of the request. Unanimously approved.

Commissioner Mannone said he would like to modify the By-Laws regarding the time of the Annual Reorganization Meeting.

MOTION

On Motion by Commissioner Mannone and seconded by Commissioner Doherty to amend the District By-Laws to hold the Annual Reorganization Meeting at 6:30 p.m. instead of 9:00 a.m. on the Monday following the Election. Unanimously approved.

Commissioner Samoles stated he would like to hire a part-time worker for the office. He said CSEA already approved the 19 ½ hour per week position. Commissioner Mannone questioned if it had to be a Civil Service Title. Commissioner Graff said he thinks the District needs to apply for a title. Commissioner Mannone said he believes Nassau County Civil Service will approve the hiring of a person that is qualified as handicap without a test.

Commissioner Doherty and the Board all agreed they would like to hire an individual with autism. Commissioner Samoles said Ms. Ashley Gazes would be paid \$15.00 per hour.
