And that nominating petition forms may be picked up beginning on May 23, 2022, at 90 Mott Street, Oceanside, New York, during regular business hours of the District. The deadline for filing petitions shall be June 1, 2022, at 1:00 PM. All filings must be made in person at the District Office."

On Motion by Commissioner Doherty and seconded by Commissioner Hemsley to approve the following regarding the June 16, 2022 Election: to hire up to 20 Election Inspectors that are residents of Sanitary District #7 (or alternatively, are residents of Nassau County certified as election inspectors by the Nassau County Board of Elections), and are to be paid \$175 for their service, candidates names will be selected randomly for order placement on the ballot, each candidate may have three poll watchers with only one present at a time, the District will rent up to four optical scanners and one Automark machine from the Nassau County Board of Elections, the District will Hire Attorney Steven Leventhal, Esq. as election counsel and for pre-election work and the opening and closing of the polls at the hourly rate set forth in the previously approved retainer agreement, each voter will be allowed up to three ballots with spoiled stickers to be used and Election Inspectors to keep track of the number of ballots used per voter, and Fort Orange Press Printers to print 3,000 bound ballots and 1000 affidavit ballots.
