Dear Friends and Members of St. John's Congregations, Brothers and Sisters in Christ Fellow Redeemed,

This year's VBS theme is "Treasures of the Kingdom". The theme song is "Lord You Are More Precious than Silver". The combined message brings us face to face with our baptism through which we are made heirs of the Kingdom (Treasure).

What an exciting message to share with those who attend VBS! What an opportunity to share the treasure that God has given to us!

Jesus is the one who teaches us that the kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure. He tells two short parables to teach us about the treasure of the kingdom.

Matthew 13: 44-45

The Parable of the Hidden Treasure

44 "The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field, which a man found and covered up. Then in his joy he goes and sells all that he has and buys that field.

The Parable of the Pearl of Great Value

45 "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like a merchant in search of fine pearls,

46 who, on finding one pearl of great value, went and sold all that he had and bought it.

Once we begin to comprehend the great value of the Kingdom and understand that we receive this as a gift by grace through faith in Jesus, then we can place the Treasure of the Kingdom as our highest priority. Jesus said in

Matthew 6:21, "where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

Following this, we understand that we have been called to be Jesus' ambassadors to spread the good news of the Kingdom to the entire world.

Jesus tells another parable that speaks about this in terms of this treasure: Matthew 13: 51-52:

51 "Have you understood all these things?" They said to him, "Yes."
52 And he said to them, "Therefore every scribe who has been trained for the kingdom of heaven is like a master of a house, who brings out of his treasure what is new and what is old."

At VBS we have a great opportunity to bring out this treasure-both old and new and share it with our children and with adults.

Come let us rejoice in the treasure that we have been given.

Along with the beautiful song—"More Precious than Silver", we have the old church hymn

which states in verses 1, 4, 6:

Jesus, Priceless Treasure

Jesus, priceless **Treasure**, Fount of purest pleasure, Truest Friend to me. Ah, how long in anguish Shall my spirit languish, Yearning, Lord, for Thee? Thou art mine, O Lamb divine! I will suffer naught to hide Thee, Naught I ask beside Thee

Hence, all earthly **treasure**! Jesus is my Pleasure, Jesus is my Choice, Hence, all empty glory! Naught to me thy story Told with tempting voice, Pain or loss, or shame or cross, Shall not from my Savior move me Since He deigns to love me.

Hence, all fear and sadness! For the Lord of gladness, Jesus, enters in. Those who love the Father, Though the storms may gather, Still have peace within. Yea, whatever I here must bear. Thou art still my purest Pleasure, Jesus priceless Treasure!

BE AN EXAMPLE, AND SHINE YOUR LIGHT

Dear Congregation,

June marks the beginning of summer and consequently summer Sunday School. This summer we will begin a series on CREATION. The series begins by discussing how God makes light in a dark world. We'll play flashlight tag, see light break into colors by shining light through a prism, and even learn that light travels in a straight line, one of the many wonders of God's creation. 


