Stewardship is the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care. (Merriam-Webster Dictionary, 2026)

- I. Genesis 1:27–28
  - A. Male and female created in the image of God
  - B. Be fruitful and multiple
  - C. Have dominion over every living thing
  
- II. Genesis 2:8-9
  - A. God placed man in the garden eastward in Eden
  - B. God planted every tree pleasant to the sight and good for food
  
- III. Genesis 2:16–17
  - A. Adam and his wife were free to eat freely of the trees of the garden
  - B. Only the tree of knowledge of good and evil were off limits
  - C. Eating of the tree of knowledge of good and evil would cause spiritual death
  
- IV. Genesis 3:17-21
  - A. The serpent's punishment
  - B. Eve's punishment
  - C. Adam's punishment
  
- V. Genesis 3:22–24
  - A. Mankind corrupted by the knowledge of good and evil
  - B. Access to the Tree of Life was revoked in the fallen, corrupt state
  - C. Mankind was relocated to his birthplace to till the ground
  - D. Cherubims guarded the gateway to the garden of Eden with a flaming sword
  
- VI. Deuteronomy 6:1–2
  - A. Moses was commanded to teach God's commandments to Israel
  - B. God wanted Israel to fear Him and keep all of his statutes and commandments

- VII. Deuteronomy 4:5-6, 13
  - A. Moses taught Israel God's statutes and judgements to conquer land
  - B. God wanted Israel to continuously keep his commandments and honor Him
  - C. God declared His covenant he wanted Israel to keep – the ten commandments
- VIII. Deuteronomy 5:1–4
  - A. God wanted Israel to learn Gods commandments and statutes, keep them, and do them.
  - B. God made a covenant with Israel in Horeb.
  - C. God was in the midst of the fire
  
- IX. Josiah - 2 Chronicles 34:31–35:1
  - A. Josiah honors God's Covenant
  - B. Josiah moved the people of Jerusalem to honor God's Covenant
  - C. Josiah removed the abominations from among the Children of Israel
  - D. Josia departed not from following the Lord
  
- X. Samuel 2:18, 3:4,10, 20
  - A. Samuel ministered before the Lord as a child
  - B. Samuel answered to the Lord " Here am I!"
  - C. The Lord called for Samuel. Samuel answered, " Speak for your servant hears."
  - D. All Israel knew Samuel was an established prophet of the Lord
  
- XI. Daniel 1:9, 17; 2:19
  - A. God had brought Daniel into favor and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs
  - B. God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams
  - C. Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.
