- I. John the Baptist - Matthew 3:11, 11:11, 21:32, Mark 6:18, 20
  - A. John baptized and preached the baptism of repentance
  - B. None risen greater than John the Baptist
  - C. John the Baptist ministered in the way of righteousness
  - D. John the Baptist spoke plain to King Herod regarding Herod's open sin
  - E. Herod knew and feared John the Baptist, who was a just man and holy
  
- II. Jesus – Matthew 3:16, 4:1, 7:29, 8:13-27, 15:32, 26:36
  - A. Jesus submitted to John the Baptist with water baptism and received the Holy Spirit and the Anointing to begin his ministry
  - B. Jesus was led of the Holy Spirit
  - C. Jesus taught with authority and not as the Scribes
  - D. Jesus had dominion over sickness and the Earth
  - E. Jesus ministered with the Gifts of the Spirit – I Corinthians 12
  - F. Jesus had compassion on the multitudes
  - G. Jesus stole away to pray
  - H. Jesus does what ever he sees the Father do – John 5:19
