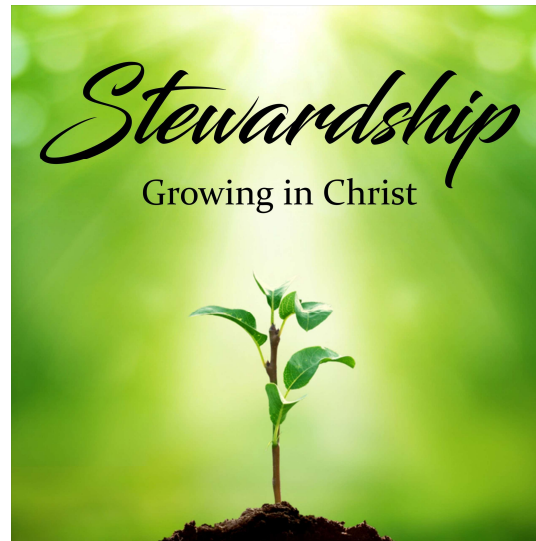

# Video 1 – A Steward's Purpose

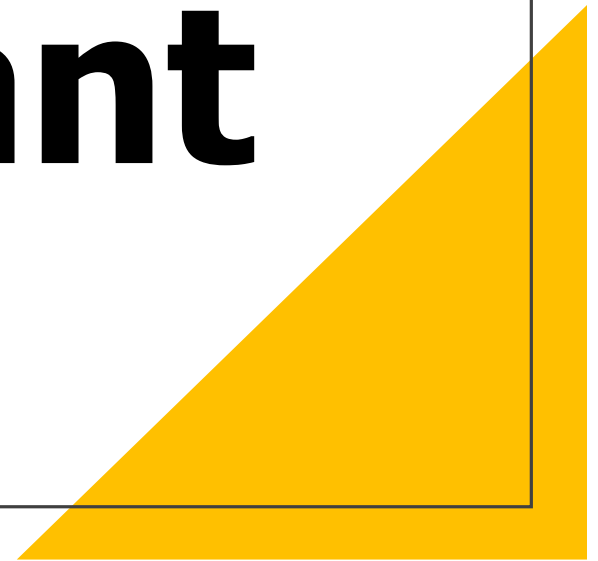
- To take what God has placed at their disposal and use it

## Video 2

- Protecting and expanding the assets of another.
- Deuteronomy 8 – why God blesses his people and works with them.
- Deuteronomy 8:18 – That he may confirm His Covenant
- We are his Kingdom stewards because we are his to confirm his covenant.
- A covenant is a divinely created bond.
- The Dominion Covenant – Genesis 1:26

## Video 2

- Tree in the middle of the Garden – You do not own this.
- House sitting – the house was not Mine. But I could use it.
- God put a reminder in the garden the tree was not theirs.
- Deuteronomy 8:11 – Beware that you do not forget the Lord your God
- By not keeping his commandments and His ordinances and His statutes which I am commanding you today;

- God has provided all.
- His resources were given for us to make wealth.
- His resources are to confirm his covenant.
- A covenant is an umbrella or a covering.
- If we are not obeying God we are not covered with/under God's covenant.
- The chain of command.

- Proverbs 30:8-9
- Keep deception and lies far from me, give me neither poverty or riches; feed me with the food that is my portion, that I not be full and deny You and say, “Who is the Lord? Or that I not be in want and steal, and profane the name of my God.

- Proverbs 30:8-9
- Give me what you know I can handle.
- God does not want us to become independent of Him because of wealth.

- Jabez prayer – increase my territory so I do not cause pain.
- He will give us more when we can handle it.
- We need an alignment.

# Psalm 128

A Song of degrees

1 Blessed is every one that feareth the Lord;  
That walketh in his ways.

2 For thou shalt eat the labour of thine hands:

3 Thy wife shall be as a fruitful vine  
By the sides of thine house:  
Thy children like olive plants  
Round about thy table.

4 Behold, that thus shall the man be blessed that feareth the Lord.

5 The Lord shall bless thee out of Zion:  
And thou shalt see the good of Jerusalem  
All the days of thy life.

6 Yea, thou shalt see thy children's children,  
And peace upon Israel.

## Video 3 – The Spheres

- The Kingdom Agenda is the visible manifestation of the rule of God in every aspect of our life.
- All of life is a Stewardship – “How blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in His ways.” Psalm 128:1
- To fear God is to take Him seriously. We are walking in His ways when He orders our steps, and our decisions are reflecting God’s perspectives.

## Video 3 – The Spheres

- Kingdom Authority – “You shall eat of the fruit of your hands, you will be happy, and it will be well with you.” Psalm 128:2
- The fruit of your hands or labor. God wants us to be productive.
- “Your wife shall be like a fruitful vine within your house, your children like olive plants around your table.” Psalm 128:3

## Video 3 – The Spheres

- Be productive, Be fruitful.
- It takes 15 years for an olive plant to become an olive tree.
- Our nation has issues because of the break down of the family. Satan wants to destroy our society – economics, labor, and work.

## Video 3 – The Spheres

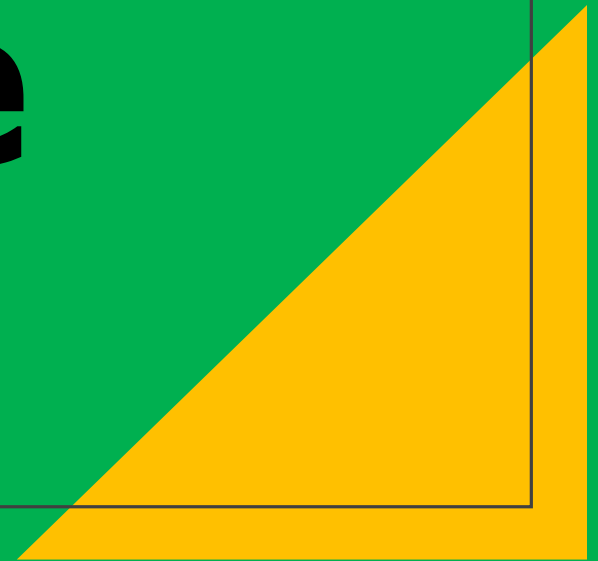
- God want to bless the Church – “The Lord bless you from Zion, and may you see the prosperity of Jerusalem all the days of your life.”  
Psalm 128:5
- God has never been alone, nor does he want his people to be in isolation.
- “May you see your children’s children.” Psalm 128:5-6

- The Kingdom Covenant produces prosperity.
- Jeremiah 29:5-7 – build houses
- Do it God's way and order will replace chaos.

## Video 4 – The Perspective

- Kingdom Steward and God's Manager under the Rulership of God
- Be Godly and Content with food and clothing - 1 Timothy 6:6-8
- Godliness and Contentment is Great Gain!
- Money can not buy everything!

## Video 4 – The Perspective

- I have learned to be content in any circumstance – Philippians 4:11
- Learning to be content is a process.
- Wanting to get rich is foolish and harmful - 1 Timothy 6:9-10
- Seek God as your highest goal!

## Video 4 – The Perspective

- Do not lose God for money or what you cannot afford.
- It is a sin not to enjoy what God gives you!
- “Instruct them to do good, rich in good works ....” I Timothy 6:18-19
- Good works benefit others. Help others for the Glory of God!

## I Timothy 6:17-19

17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;

18 That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;

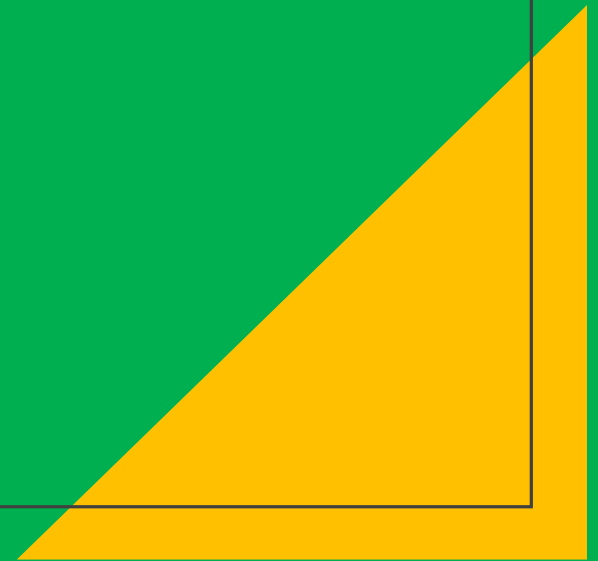
19 Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

# Video 5 – The Motivation

2 Corinthians 9:6-8

- Sows sparingly = Reap sparingly
- Sows **bountifully** = Reap bountifully
- Do as he or she **purposed** in his heart

# Video 5 – The Motivation

2 Corinthians 9:6-8

- No grudgingly. God loves a **cheerful** giver
- **Grace** abound to you = Having **all sufficiency** in everything
- **Abundance** for every **good deed**

# Video 5 – The Motivation – Farming Principal

- Grace is free. Grace can be accessed.
- No farmer eats his or her whole harvest.
- What we plant yields more fruit than we planted.
- Planting seed requires action. Prayer must follow with action.

# Video 5 – The Motivation

- Sown in expectation of a harvest but the harvest is not instant.
- God's grace covers every aspect of our lives.
- Luke 6:38 – Give
- God provides everything needed for the harvest.
- God is the source.

# Video 5 – The Motivation

- I Chronicles 29:10-12
- Ecclesiastes 11:1 – Cast your bread on the surface of the waters, for you will find it after many days.
- Sow in one season and reap in another.
