Faith – Pistis - conviction of the truth (that God, Jesus exists), respect for man's relationship to God.

Endure – Hupomeno - to bear bravely and calmly, to remain or tarry behind, hold fast to one's faith in Christ.

Theme Scripture - Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. **Hebrews 12:2**

And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself Colossians 1:20

Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, to obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you, and peace, be multiplied. 1 Peter 1:2
