

FAQ?

i. What is International Women in Cyber Day (IWCD)?

- International Women in Cyber Day is a global movement of women and male advocates petitioning national governments with the intent of having this special day recognized by the United Nations.

ii. Why is this needed?

- There is a lack of diversity and inclusion for women who make up a very small percentage of the cybersecurity workforce. It is generally accepted; women hold about 11% of the jobs globally. See *infographic for more details.*

Increase the Cybersecurity Workforce
Support and sign our petition!

- Women make up only about **10%** of the cybersecurity workforce.
- Enrollment is as low as **11%** in cyber-related programs.
- Research has shown **50% of women will drop out of ICT** within the first four years.
- By **2021**, an estimated **3.5 million jobs** in cybersecurity will go unfilled.
- Cyber attacks **cost the economy trillions of dollars** yearly.
- The **cybersecurity workforce protects national and economic assets.**
- Research shows **diversity of thought** adds to **increased profits, increased problem solving** and **higher resolution.**
