The Family Share Basket allows children to take the lead in sharing more about themselves and the important people in their lives. It encourages self-expression, communication, and the development of a sense of community in a warm, Montessori environment.

When it's your child's turn to share, here are some ideas to help guide their presentation, though these are just suggestions! The goal is for your child to share something meaningful to them, allowing them to feel proud of their family while practicing independence and confidence:

A small plant or bouquet of flowers that the children can help care for together in the classroom, bringing a little bit of nature into their daily experience.

A favorite book your child enjoys reading, so they can share their love of stories with the class.

A personal item that your child holds dear, such as a special toy, a treasured gift/trophy, or something that reflects their hobbies or interests. This is a great way for them to express themselves and connect with their peers.

Family photos that highlight special moments or events in your family's life. This could be from a memorable vacation/outing, a holiday celebration, or simply a fun day spent together. These pictures give children a chance to practice storytelling and share what's important to them.

This is a wonderful chance for children to feel valued and heard, to take pride in their family, and to learn more about each other. We're excited to see how this experience will help each child share more about themselves, building connections with friends and fostering a deeper sense of community in our classroom.
