**There will be a \$100 fine for any horses found in the RV park area. This is strictly enforced by the fairgrounds crew.

HEALTH DOCUMENTS:

ALL out of state horses, including noncompete horses, will require a negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia, and a health certificate dated within 6 months of our show.

PHOTOGRAPHER:

MVRCHA Official Photographer is Rockin' Horse Photography. A Photo booth may be available to view your photos, free of charge, located on the fairgrounds area*. Photos will also be available on their website at www.rockinhorsephotography.photorelect.com

*Location will vary day by day. Follow them on Facebook to see exactly where they will be.

VIDEOGRAPHER:

MVRCHA Official Videographer is Raindancer Video. Because of the size of the fairgrounds, an immediate replay monitor may or may not be available. You can visit Raindancer's trailer located next to grandstand stairs to rewatch your runs free of charge. You may purchase your videos from Raindancer and contact information will be provided at his trailer.



FUTURITY, DERBY & SPECTACULAR ENTRIES:

All class eligibility is governed by the **NRCHA 2026 Rulebook**. Contestants are entirely responsible for knowing their level of eligibility and entering accordingly.

- **Entries due on/before Friday, July 31, 2026, or a \$100 late fee will be assessed.**
- **Draw date is Tuesday, 8/4/2026 in the morning – if you enter after the draw you will be drawn first or last in a set at the discretion of the MVRCHA and a late fee assessed.**
- LAE & Spectacular Late entries will be accepted until noon the day before the class begins. Late fees will be charged to any entry received after the entry deadline. Late Entries received after the draw will be drawn first or last in a set at the discretion of the MVRCHA. Late fees are not charged to add classes or divisions to the original entry that was on time for that horse, AND before the draw.
- **SCRATCH POLICY:** Deadline to scratch with no fees is **Monday, 8/3/26 before 10pm/MT**
- Scratch after the deadline, but before the draw – Responsible for cattle fee and office fee
- Scratch after the draw – All fees except NRCHA and Video fees must be paid.

HORSE SHOW:

All class eligibility is governed by the **NRCHA 2026 Rulebook**. Contestants are entirely responsible for knowing their level of eligibility and entering accordingly.

- Must enter before **noon the day before** the class, or a \$100 late fee will be assessed, and you will be drawn first or last in a set at the discretion of the MVRCHA.
- **SCRATCH POLICY:** Deadline to scratch with no fees is **1:00 pm the day before class**
- Scratch after the deadline, but before the draw – Responsible for cattle and office fee
- Scratch after the draw – All fees except NRCHA and Video fees must be paid.



ENTRIES:

You can enter online at www.mvrcha.com/showinfo via Equinal, the online entry form.

- **Providing a Social Security Number is mandatory for any earning checks to be processed. If you have won a check, you will be required to fill out or provide an up-to-date W9. Missing or incomplete entries will not be processed.**
- All check payments are made to MVRCHA. Payment by credit card will have a processing fee of 4% added.
- Any payments that come back to MVRCHA for lack of funds will be charged an additional fee of \$50
- Provided credit card numbers and checks will not be charged or deposited until your show bill has been closed at the show office. This is to hold your entry.
- If you do not close out your show bill, it will be closed for you utilizing the payment method provided on your entry.
- If refunds are owed, MVRCHA will issue a check to the payee unless otherwise directed. Refunds are issued within 10 business days of the conclusion of the show.

REQUIREMENTS SUMMARY:

Copies of the following must be submitted to complete your entry:

- Entry Form
- MVRCHA Membership – must be a member in good standing. If not current member, you will be required to complete the membership form at show office.
- NRCHA Membership – must be a member in good standing. If you are not a current member, you will be required to complete the membership form at show office.
- Coggins and Health Certificate – see general health requirements



ANIMAL WELFARE:

The Magic Valley Reined Cow Horse Association takes seriously the welfare of the equine partners and the cattle that allow for participation in our sanctioned events. Animal use is deeply ingrained in our society, benefiting the health of people, supporting commerce, and enhancing our enjoyment of life. MVRCHA acknowledges the valuable role of these animal partners in our lives, in history and in horse shows and is committed to providing a proper environment for them in competition, in transport and at rest, and to providing humane guidelines for care and treatment of both horses and cattle. Inhumane treatment of the equine partners we ride or the cattle vital to our competition is not acceptable and anyone observed violating the welfare of these animals will be immediately ejected.

PAYMENT POLICY:

Upon check-in you can provide a check or credit card in the Horse Show Office then at checkout you can pay with check or credit card. In the event no charges are incurred during the event, your check will be returned to you. Any practice pen charges will be added to your show tab.

All show tabs MUST be closed out at the horse show. Show office reserves the right to close your tab via the payment method on file at end of business the day you are done showing. Should your account be closed out using the card on file and you wish to change payment to a check, credit card fees will not be returned. Payments using a credit card will incur a 4% fee. Any NSF checks or credit cards will be charged a \$50 NSF fee. Any tabs that are not paid in full at the end of the show (including scratched entries) will be charged a \$50 late fee*.

PAYOUT REQUIREMENTS:

In order to receive your win checks from the show, you must have a current W-9 on file with the MVRCHA Office. W-9's can be filled out in the Horse Show Office shortly after the class has ended. You will not be able to receive your check without a current W-9 on file with the MVRCHA.
