After breakfast at the hotel drive to Pondicherry. Enroute visit Marakanam Village and visit some people making seafaring boats. Check into hotel on arrival at Pondicherry. After lunch, Pondicherry city tour including visit to Aurobindo Ashram. Overnight Hotel in Pondicherry.



Day 04: Pondicherry- Thanjavur

After early breakfast at the hotel drive to Chidambaram and visit Natarajaswami Temple – famous for Lord Shiva's cosmic dance. Later drive to Thanjavur and check into hotel. Evening visit to The Big Temple. Overnight Hotel in Thanjavur.



Day 05: Thanjavur- Madurai

After early breakfast at the hotel drive to Sri Rangam and visit Sri Ranganathaswami Temple – known for its tallest temple tower (Gopuram). Later drive to Tiruchirappalli and visit local market. Later drive to Madurai and check into hotel. Watch the night ceremony at Meenakshi Amman Temple after checking into hotel. Overnight Hotel in Madurai.



Day 06: Madurai- Kanyakumari

After breakfast drive to Kanyakumari and check into resort. Evening visit to Vivekananda Rock Memorial and Thiruvalluvar Statue by the Government Ferry. Overnight Hotel in Kanyakumari.



Day 07: Kanyakumari- Cochin

Early morning watch the spectacular Sun rise across the Indian Ocean. After breakfast drive to Cochin and check into hotel on arrival. Overnight Hotel in Cochin.



Day 08: Cochin


Day 09: Cochin- Bangalore- Mysore

Day 01: Cochin – Munnar

Pickup from Cochin Airport/ Railway Station and transfer to Munnar (140 Kms / 4 hrs) the lovely hill station, filled with tea plantations and misty mountains. The drive to Munnar is very scenic crossing the narrow hair – pin roads where you see beautiful valleys, tea gardens and small waterfalls on the way. Vallera & Kallar waterfalls. Sightseeing includes Pothenmedu view point. Check into hotel. Overnight Hotel in Munnar.



Day 02 : Munnar

After breakfast proceed to Munnar, on the way visit tea and spice plantations, Cheeyappara waterfalls, view point etc. Arrive Munnar and check in your hotel. Rest of the day free for your own activities. Mattupetty Dam, Echo point, kundala dam, Rajamalai you could find NILGIRI THAR, an endangered species, Tea museum. Overnight Hotel in Munnar.



Day 03: Munnar – Kumarakom

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Kumarakom (170 km/05 hrs) – world's one and only beautiful & delighted backwater destination, check in to the resort the day free to explore the resort, with the surroundings of backwater. Overnight Hotel in Kumarakom.



Day 04: Houseboat at Alleppey

Breakfast at hotel, transfer to Alleppey, check into houseboat, and enjoy & experience the full day back water life. Cruise will cover the canals & village area also. Lunch, evening tea, dinner & breakfast will be serving at houseboat. The food is authentic kerala cuisine. Overnight aboard in Houseboat.



Day 05: Alleppey – Kovalam

After breakfast, check out from houseboat and proceeds to Kovalam (160 km/ 4 hrs). The famous beach destination in South India. Check into the hotel. Enjoy in soft evening beach. Overnight Hotel in Kovalam.



Day 06: Kovalam

After breakfast proceeds to sightseeing in there you can visit Sri Chitra Art Gallery – house paintings from the Mughal, Rajput and Tanjore schools of art. Besides these, the gallery has a rare collection of paintings by Raja Ravi Varma, Svetoslav and Nicholas Roerich. An Oriental collection consisting of paintings from China, Japan, Tibet and Bali are a visual treat to the visitor. You can also visit zoo, museum, Shangumugham beach etc. Overnight Hotel in Kovalam.



Day 07: Kovalam – Trivandrum (Departure)

Today you will be transferred to Trivandrum International Airport in time to connect for your flight to Home.



KARNATAKA KALEIDOSCOPE – 14 NIGHTS / 15 DAYS



Day 01: Arrive Bangalore

Meet & Greet on arrival and transfer to the hotel. Depending on the arrival time, half day sightseeing tour of ISKCON Temple – built in an architectural style, the Krishna Temple is a blend of Modern technology and spiritual harmony, Tippu's Palace – Built in 1791, Tippu Sultan's summer retreat is a two-storied ornate wooden structure with fluted pillars, cusped arches and balconies. It now houses a museum that contains artifacts relating to the Hyder – Tipu regime. Later in the evening visit Indira Gandhi Musical Fountain - View the colorful swirling fountains dancing in tune to music, free for shopping at night. Overnight Hotel in Bangalore.



Day 02: Bangalore - Mysore

After breakfast drive to Mysore. Enroute visit Srirangapatna – Island fortress of Tippu Sultan, the legendary Tiger of Mysore who put up a valiant fight against British domination. Visit Tippu's Summer Palace, Mosque and Sriranganatha Temple. On arrival at Mysore check into hotel. After lunch local sightseeing tour of Maharaja Palace – built in 1911-12 by Wodeyar Rulers, the palace is a splendid structure in the Indo - Saracenic Style, among its many attractions is a magnificent gold throne displayed during the Dussehra celebrations. It is an entirely modern structure continuing the Hindu and saracenic styles of architecture, Mysore Zoo – established with royal patronage in the 19th century, the zoo's collection of fauna includes rare and exotic species of animals housed in lush green environs, and in the evening visit Brindavan Garden – the famous gardens at the Krishna Raja Sagar Dam after sundown, when musical fountains and colored lights transform this place into a magical fairytale. Overnight Hotel in Mysore.



Day 03: Mysore

After breakfast, full day tour of Somnathpura – situated in the unobtrusive village, 35 kms from Mysore. The exquisitely carved, star shaped temple with triple towers is a perfect example of Hoysala architecture. Also visit Talakadu – situated on the banks of Cauvery, famously known as the Vaideshwara Temple, is now completely buried beneath sand dues. The temple comes to life when it is excavated once every 12 years during the Panchalinga Darshan. Return back to Mysore. Overnight Hotel in Mysore.



Day 04: Mysore - Madikeri

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and drive to Madikeri. Enroute visit Bylakuppe – largest Tibetan settlement in Karnataka, Golden Temple, Sera Je Monastic University & Tibetan handicraft Center and Cauvery Nisargadhama, island near Kushalnagar. You may go for optional boating or Elephant ride (subject to availability). On arrival at Madikeri, check in to a Home stay. Later in the evening visit to Raja Seat – from here you can see one of most beautiful scenery around Madikeri town and watch for Sunset, Madikeri Fort – was first built as a mud fort by Mudduraja in the last quarter of the 17th century. He also built a palace inside the fort. It was eventually rebuilt in granite by Tippu Sultan who named the site as Jaffarabad. Overnight Hotel in Madikeri.



Day 05: Madikeri

Morning after breakfast, full day sightseeing tour of Tala Cauvery – from where the Kaveri River originates in the Brahmagiri hills, is considered among the most sacred places in Karnataka. It is at a height of around 1276 m above sea level. This is a sacred pilgrim center among the Kodavas, Bhagamandala – also known as Bhagundeshwara Kshetra, is a temple town. When the river Cauvery flows downhill, two more tributaries namely Kanake and Sujyoti join it. The spot where all three converge is called Bhagamandala. Return back to the Home Stay and lunch. In the afternoon, visit to Abbey Falls – tucked away between private coffee and spice estates, Abbey Falls offers a splendid backdrop for picnics. As you make your way past stocky coffee bushes and tall trees entwined with pepper vines the falls make a sudden and dramatic appearance as they cascade their way down steps into limpid pools to join the river Cauvery. Overnight Hotel in Madikeri.



Day 06: Madikeri - Hassan

After breakfast, checkout and drive to Hassan. Enroute visit the famous Shravanabelagola – Jain's Pilgrim Center – the monolith statue of Lord Gomateshwara, a Jain saint. Standing atop, one of the hills (Indragiri hills) is 18 mts height and is said to be one of the tallest and most graceful monolithic statues in the world. The symmetry in stone was created around 938 AD by Chamundaraya, a general and minister of Ganga, King Rachamatta. Check in to hotel on arrival and rest of the day free to relax. Overnight Hotel in Hassan.



Day 07: Hassan

After breakfast, full day sightseeing, visit to Belur – on the banks of the Yagachi River in Belur, a star – shaped temple with hand lathe-turned filigreed pillars and sculptures will take your breath away. It is the only Hoysala temple still in active worship. Friezes of charging elephants, each different from the other, mythological figures, military scenes, dancers & musicians and elaborate decorative motifs recharge the imagination. The winged figure of Garuda, Lord Vishnu's carrier, stands at the entrance facing the temple, palms touching in homage. The most marvelous specimens of Hoysala architecture found exclusively at Belur. Halebid - Just 17 kms away from Belur is Halebid, the ancient capital of the Hoysalas. The temple, perched on a star-shaped base amidst lawns, is a sculptural extravaganza. Its walls are richly carved with an endless variety of Hindu deities, sages, stylized animals, birds and friezes depicting the life of the Hoysala kings. The temple complex has a museum which houses the idols, statues, busts and sculptures excavated by the Archaeological Department from the ruins. Overnight Hotel in Hassan



Day 08: Hassan - Udupi

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and drive to Udupi to check into the resort. Rest of the day free to rest & relax at the Spa Resort. Overnight Resort in Udupi.



KARNATAKA KALEIDOSCOPE – 14 NIGHTS / 15 DAYS 03 NIGHTS




Day 09: Udupi

After breakfast, visit St. Mary's Island or Coconut Island which is one of the many Karnataka tourist places consisting of 4 small islands off the Arabian sea coast. These islands can be reached from Malpe Beach through a boat. Return back to the resort and later on avail the activities at the resort. Overnight Resort in Udupi.



Day 10: Udupi - Karwar

After breakfast, check out of the resort and drive to Gokarna. On arrival at Gokarna, check into the farm resort. Overnight Resort in Karwar.



Day 11: Karwar - Hospet (Hampi)

After early breakfast, checkout and drive to Hampi – the World Heritage Center, which is the most beautiful and evocative of all the ruins in Karnataka. Capital of Vijaya Nagar kingdom this place is full of delightful surprises. On arrival check into hotel and later on sightseeing, tour of the King's Palace – which includes the largest enclosure, two major platform structures, an underground chamber which must have served as a treasury or private audience hall, several other platforms, double fortification walls and several other interesting architectural elements. Equally impressive is the massive Mahanavami Dibba, where the kings once sat on gem-studded golden thrones and watched processions pass by. The platform sports densely carved bands of horses, soldiers and depictions of the various aspects of courtly life. Queen's Bath – this structure has a very plain exterior but the interior is stunningly ornate, with graceful arched corridors, projecting balconies and lotus – shaped fountains that used to spout perfumed water for the ladies of the court. Overnight Resort in Hampi.



Day 12: Hampi

After breakfast and full day sightseeing tour of Lotus Mahal – this visually appealing structure has two levels, with open pavilions at the bottom and balconies above. An elegant example of the fusion of the Hindu and Muslim styles of architecture, the Mahal derives its name from its beautiful, geometrically-arranged cusped arches that resemble the petals of a flower opening to the sun. Elephant Stables – an imposing edifice with arched entrances and many domes that once housed the magnificent state elephants. Pushkarni – this stepped water tank, excavated in the mid-1980s, was originally a part of the palace complex. Almost lyrical in its beauty, the tank is a tiered structure crafted from rectangular pieces of granite. Hazara Rama Temple – this was a royal temple reserved for ceremonial use. The entire temple is embellished with bas-reliefs depicting scenes from the epic 'Ramayana'. The walls of the enclosure are richly carved with friezes depicting processions of horses, elephants, dancing girls and soldiers attired in splendid weaponry. Inside, four exquisitely sculpted granite pillars add to the beauty of the ardha mantapa. Overnight Resort in Hampi.

Day 01: Paro – Thimphu

On arrival at Paro airport meet, greet and drive to Thimphu, which takes about an hour. Later, after lunch, visit Tashicho Dzong, which is the main Govt. center with kings' throne room and Farmer's Market. Overnight Hotel in Thimphu.



Day 02: Thimphu

After breakfast visit The capital of Bhutan also has most things to see for visitors. A full day tour of Thimphu's cultural sites and monuments may include Memorial Chorten, traditional Art school or Painting school, Indigenous Hospital, Nunnery at Zilukha, a short drive up to a view point for aerial view of the capital and its suburbs. Along the way, visit Takin Sanctuary, the national animal of Bhutan. Also visit giant Buddha statue. There are others like Zangdopelri temple, Changangkha monastery, Simtokha Dzong, Crafts workshop, Textile museum which can be visited as per available time or based on your interests. Overnight Hotel in Thimphu..




Day 03: Thimphu – Punakha / Wangdue

After breakfast, the drive from Thimphu to Punakha across spectacular Dochula takes about 03 hrs. From Thimphu, road climbs up to Dochula pass (3,050m), where you have opportunity to view the peaks of the eastern Himalayas. Descend into Wangdue/Punakha valley. Punakha-Wangdue valley is lower (about 1450m above sea level) and it enjoys sub-tropical climate. In the afternoon, visit impressive Punakha Dzong at the confluence of the two rivers. Later drive short distance north through the idyllic countryside and walk short distance uphill to Khamsum Chorten on Nyenzangang hill. The views from here of the terraced rice fields, dotted with traditional houses, the river and the valley surrounded by mountains is amazing ! On the way to the hotel, stop to visit the township of Punakha at Khuruthang. Overnight Resort in Punakha.



Day 04: Punakha – Paro

After breakfast, check-out of the hotel and take a short walk into the village and visit Chimi Lhakhang temple, dedicated to Lam Drukpa Kuenley, affectionately known as "Divine Madman," for his unconventional ways of teaching using dirty jokes. He is a folk hero and a cultural icon around whom countless yarns of facts and fiction, stories and legends have been spun. Make a brief tour of Wangdue Phodrang; view the ruins of its Dzong, drive through the town area, and return drove to Thimphu re-crossing magnificent Dochula pass, with one more opportunity to see the panoramic views of the Eastern Himalayan peaks. (If you are interested in walking, you can skip Chimi Lhakhang & Wangdue this morning and instead take a beautiful hike for about 3hrs from Dochula to Trashigang monastery via Lungchuzekha monastery. The hike is quite easy or moderate. From Trashigang meet the vehicle and drive to Thimphu). After Thimphu, continue 01hr drive to Paro. Along the way, there is a nice small nunnery at Sitsina that you can visit. Upon arrival in Paro, stroll around the town and the check-into your hotel for dinner and overnight. Overnight Hotel in Paro.




Day 06: Paro

After breakfast your journey in Kingdom culminates with a hike to the most famous pilgrimage site in Bhutan: Taktsang Goemba (tiger's nest) monastery (at about 3100m/10,100ft). Visible from afar, this magical monastery clings to a vertical granite cliff 1,000 feet above the valley floor, defying logic, gravity, and reason in the quest for spiritual enlightenment. It is one of the most amazing and important pieces of architecture in Bhutan. (If for some reason, some of the members wish to skip hike to Taktsang, our Guide and driver can arrange other interesting alternatives for them.) You can also hire pony for the uphill part, till the first view point & cafeteria but you must be able to walk back downhill on return. The steep hike to the first view point or cafeteria (at 2940m/9,650ft) takes between 1-2hrs (ascending about 300m/1,000ft) from the starting point. From here it is another half hour or so to higher spectacular lookout point after ascending another 200m/650ft that puts you eyeball to eyeball with the monastery. From this vantage point, Taktsang seems close enough to touch but it is on the far side of deep chasm and takes a knee breaking descent and ascending of another 40 minutes or so to the monastery. While some will probably not make it all the way to the monastery, but even to get to the first view point is really worth all the effort. Upon return from the hike, we may have time to visit the ruins of Drugyal Dzong. Farewell dinner. Overnight Hotel in Paro.



Day 07: Paro

After breakfast check out from hotel and transfer to Paro International airport to board flight for onward destination.
