van meeting, our financial institution Broadway Bank gave us a quick rundown of our



financial position and recommended from which accounts to pull money for capital expenditures. This Divan, Your Board of Directors, is working hard to keep our building trouble-free to serve you best and maintain our competitive edge in rentals. Alzafar is a typical Shrine Center with the Black Camel, and for Non-Payment of dues drawing away our dear members at a rate of 5% per annum. Frankly speaking, our membership dues and a World Class rental venue are counterintuitive. We will always need your input on how you would suggest that we spend our money. However, just as importantly, if not more so, we need your expertise to show us how to make more money.

And in other business!

Alzafar Shrine Hospital Gala, October 7th. The first committee meeting will be on March 15th at 6pm. We will hold this meeting in either the Nemnuf/AMC room. 
through various presentations. Much information was given by the leaders of our great fraternity about what's coming up in the future. I can tell you we are in great hands moving forward.

Last year was a milestone in dollars that were generated from all the events and shows, and this year's budget is over \$800,000, while still being competitive with other venues in San Antonio area. With the size of our building, the expenses are just as large. Just an example is the utilities are over \$100,000 a year. Our insurance bill was \$162,000. Several of the areas that we have been reviewing are how to reduce the cost of running it. We are looking at all the expenses and seeing how we can cut costs by finding better prices, changing vendors, fixing it ourselves or even doing without. 


