Covid-19 Operational Changes

No changes have been made to our weekly trash (**grey cart**) and recycling (**blue cart**) collection schedule. To ensure that all trash and recycling is collected, please make sure that all materials are at the curb/street line by 6 a.m. on your regular collection day.

Effective Monday, March 30, 2020 until further notice

- 1. Support for community clean-ups is suspended.
- 2. Customers who have been provided with trash carts must set-out waste in those carts only.
 - 1. Trash or recycling, other than collapsed cardboard, placed outside the county-provided cart will not be collected. No privately-owned carts will be serviced.
- 3. The creation of new sanitary districts has been suspended.
- 4. Support for Operation Stream Shield (litter removal program) is suspended.
