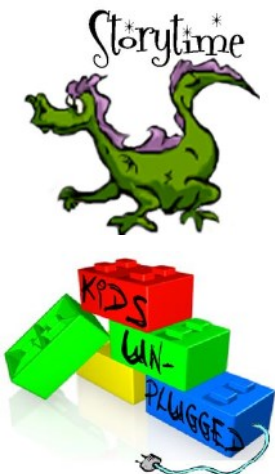

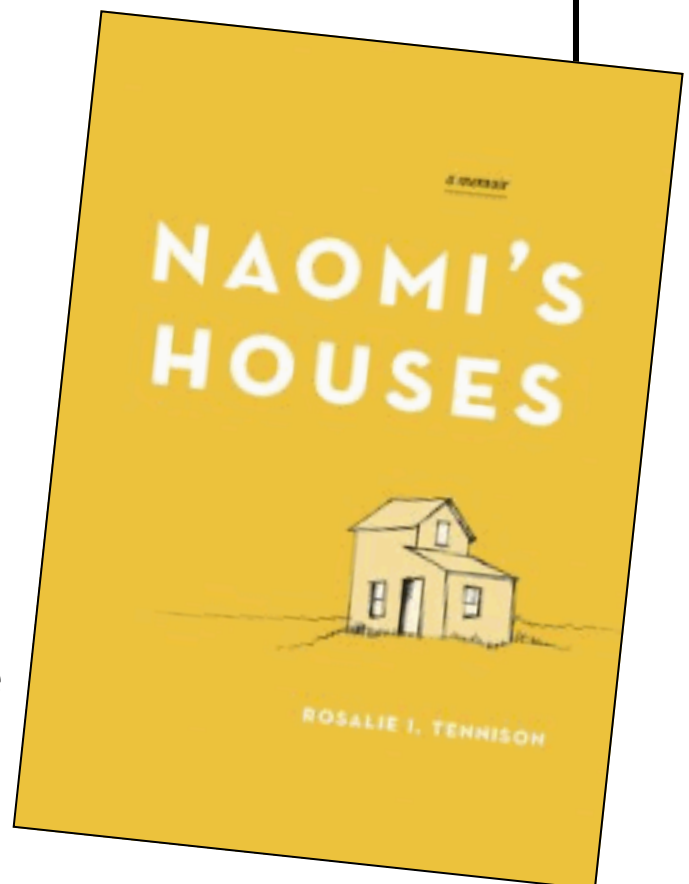

Rosalie I. Tennison, author of the book ***Naomi's Houses: A Memoir*** will be visiting.

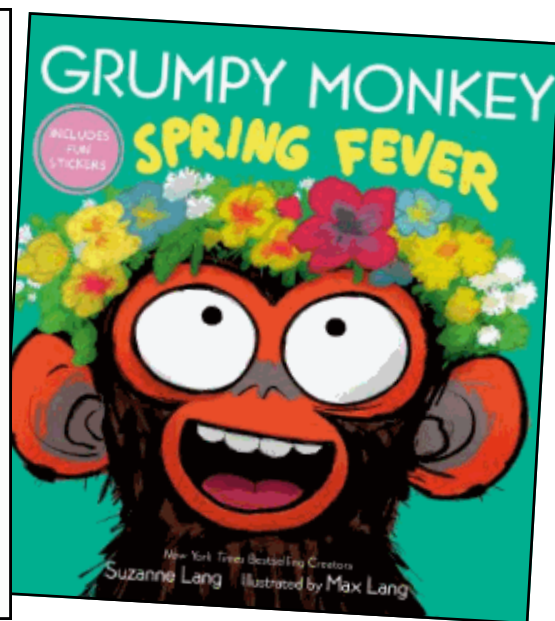
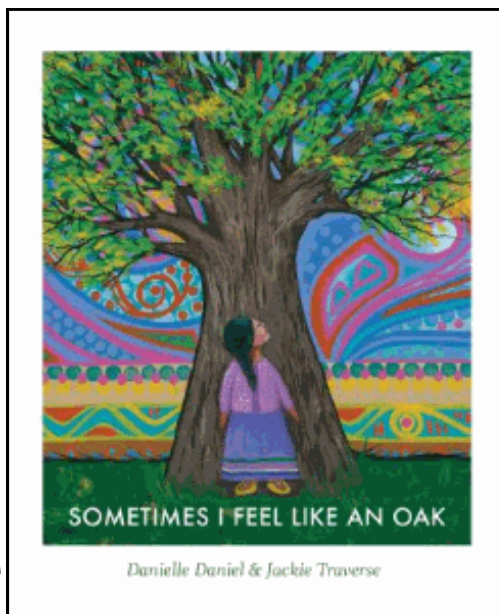
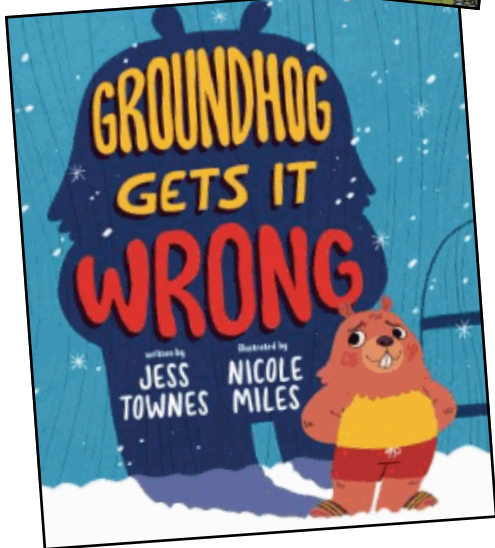
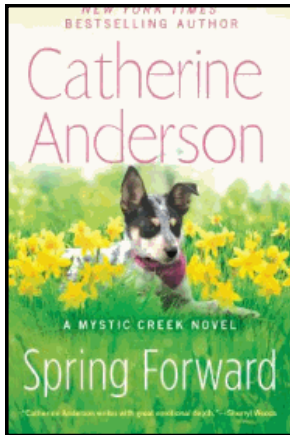
Author Rosalie Tennison's powerful memoir exposes the beauty and resilience in her humble upbringing.
