## INTERLAKE-EASTERN RHA MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS SERVICES

#### What is a CRISIS?

- An urgent difficulty or acute change
- A disruption or breakdown in your daily living pattern
- Panic attacks/extreme anxiety
- A temporary inability to cope
- · A feeling of being out of control
- Suicidal behavior or intention

If you or someone is experiencing a crisis, contact the 24 Hour Crisis Line for support.

24 Hour Crisis Line: Provides telephone support for those in the Interlake-Eastern RHA who are experiencing a mental health or psychosocial crisis.

Crisis Stabilization Unit: Nurse managed admission unit - provides short term intervention for individuals experiencing a mental health or psychosocial crisis.

Individuals are encouraged to contact Central Intake on behalf of themselves, but with the individual's consent, referrals are also accepted from other services involved.

- Adult Community Mental Health Program: Provides a range of therapeutic and supportive services that include CBTm classes, Brief Treatment, Shared Care and other supportive services to adults who are experiencing symptoms suggestive of mental health or co-occurring disorder.
- Child & Adolescent Mental Health Program: Provides therapeutic and supportive services to individuals under the age of 18 years who are experiencing symptoms suggestive of a mental health or co-occurring disorder. The team provides education and support to families as well.
- Mental Health Services for the Elderly (MHSE): Provides assessment and treatment recommendations for older individuals with mental health concerns and/or cognitive difficulties affecting their daily life activities, as well as support and education to families and caregivers.
- Intensive Case Management Program (ICM): Provides rehabilitationoriented case management services with an emphasis on the development of skills and supports needed to obtain and sustain their chosen goal of housing, education, and/or employment.
- Relational Therapy (Couple & Family): Provides therapeutic services to couples and families who reside in the IERHA to help find resolutions for problems between partners, parents and children, in-laws, or even employer and employees. Individuals can self-refer for this free service.
