

### Library News

#### Happy New Year!

As we felt the effects of COVID-19 on our province and community, staff and patrons alike adjusted to the chaos and challenges of 2020. The Gaynor Family Regional Library was a leader in face mask policies, early COVID-19 practices and the move to alternative services. We will continue these practices as we go into 2021.

In 2020, most of our programs moved from in-person to digital and our physical book borrowing moved from in-person to CurbSide. The Library in total, lent 161,706 items with a retail value of 4.2 million dollars. While our circulation numbers were down, the efforts of staff to loan and receive items was increased many times over. We lent 120,870 physical items (down 35% from 2019), while eBook borrowing increased to 40,836 (up 44% from 2019). From early reports, our Library region did better than most public libraries in the province.

Our 2021 planning is based on the expectation that the vaccine will be widely distributed and be in the arms of folks by the end of summer. Then we can return to normal in-person programming in the fall. As of now we will continue to follow the Provincial recommendations/requirements regarding the public in the facility.

We are so pleased that we were able to adjust and continue to serve the community in 2020. We are hopeful for the New Year and pleased that all our library patrons and staff have done so well in these trying times.

The Library is partnering with local artists and Indigenous leaders to create a permanent art display in the Urban Prairie, located behind the Library.
