Coffee and tea will be served by the Brew and Bake.

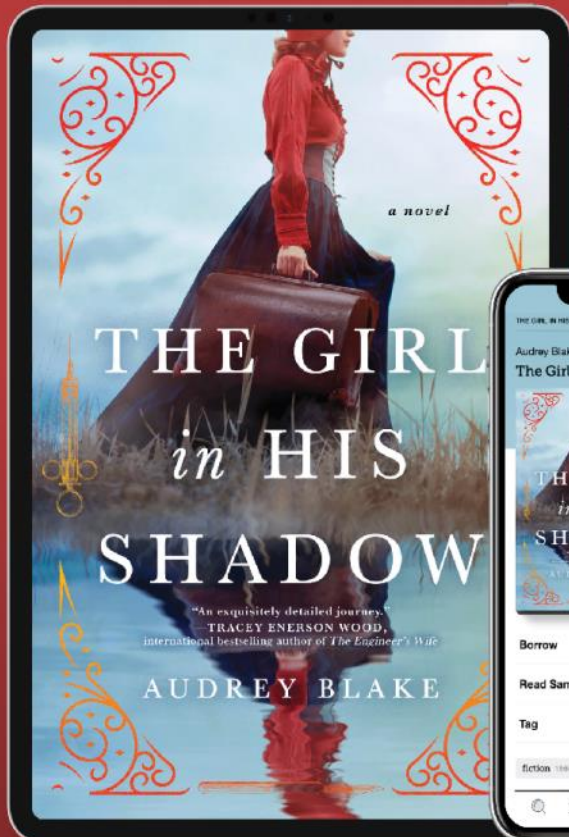

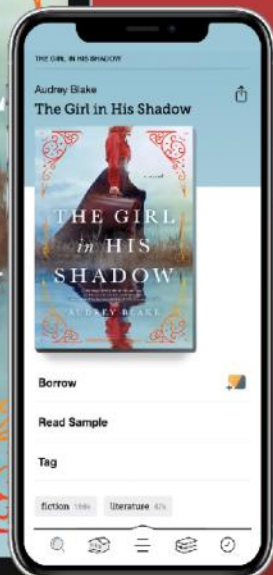
