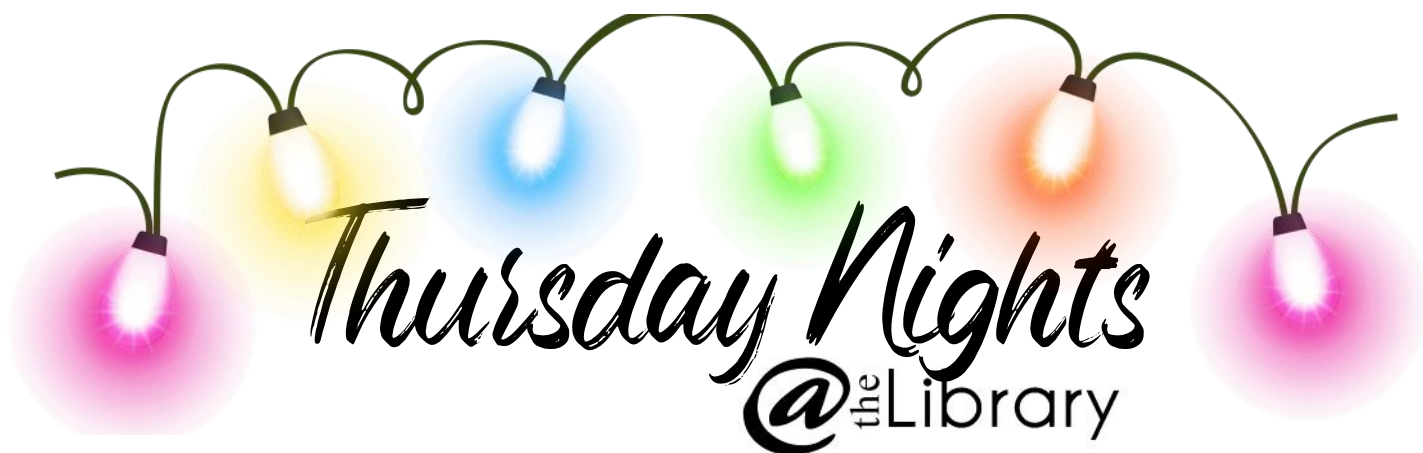
Enjoy songs and stories with you and your kiddo ages 0-5.
