
David A. Robertson

Robertson has published well over 25 books across a variety of genres including young adult and children's works. His award-winning work reflects Indigenous cultures, histories and communities, while highlighting contemporary issues. Many of his writings are widely used in libraries and classrooms across Canada.

In 2021, Robertson won the Writers' Union of Canada Freedom to Read Award and the Alexander Kennedy Isbister Award at the 2021 Manitoba Book Awards.
