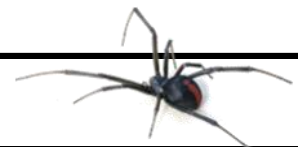

MANIDOONSAG IMAA MIKINAAKO-MINISIING SACRED SPIRITS OF TURTLE ISLAND

Monday, October 4th at Noon

Commemorating the history and legacy of the Missing and Murdered Women and Girls & Two-Spirited - October 4th is MMIWG2S Awareness Day.

The amphitheater space sets a feeling of standing within the shell of the turtle's structure where community and MMIWG2S families can gather and help heal together.

Join us as we unveil the art installation created to be a double sided, interactive, amphitheater shaped sculptural mural that measures over 2000sf or 70ft in diameter. Each section measures 32' in length and aligns with the four directions of traditional teachings, depicting the journey of the cycle of life and a Spiritual Path of the Indigenous People of Turtle Island.
