Public library services will be provided in an environment that encourages and supports all members of the public to develop their full potential.

The Library is administered by a volunteer Library Board of citizens appointed by the City of Selkirk, the R.M. of St. Andrews, the R.M. of St. Clements and the Village of Dunnottar. Funding is provided by municipal contributions from the City of Selkirk, the R.M. of St. Andrews, the R.M. of St. Clements, the Village of Dunnottar and the Province of Manitoba.

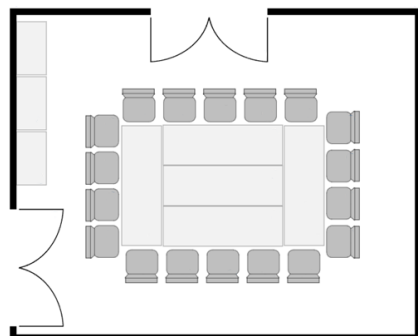

Robert Jefferson Heritage Room

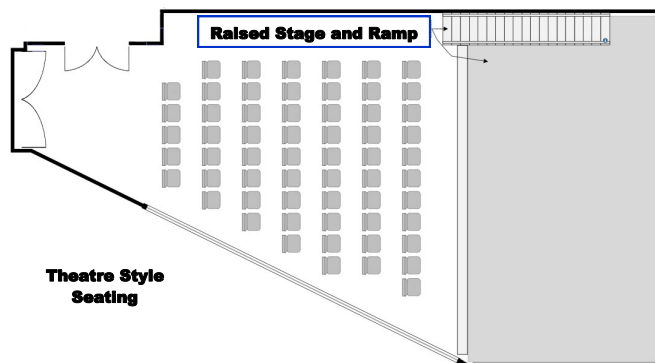
A standard board room style space that will seat 18. We offer a short throw projection unit with Bose speakers and HDMI or VGA connections for your AV equipment.



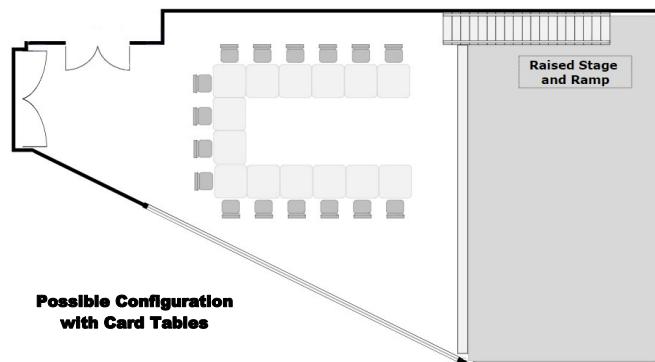
Our Space

Theatre Style Seating

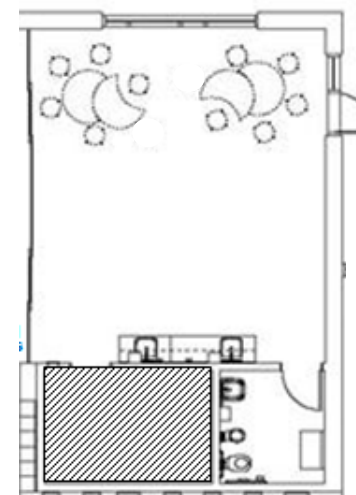


Possible Configuration with Card Tables
