
Visit with Author - Julia Penny Thursday, October 2nd 7:00 – 8:30pm , Theatre From All Walks of Life by Julia Penny

She created 151 portraits and wrote their stories next to their


Visit with Author - Raye Anderson Friday, October 24th 2:00 – 3:30pm , Theatre Had a Great Fall - Book Launch
