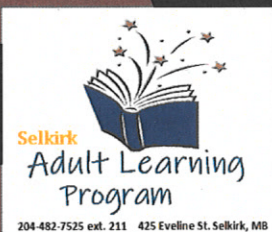

Selkirk & Community Writing Contest Guidelines- 2026

How to Enter

1. Fill out the official entry form online using this link:

- Entries **must** include a completed entry form.
- Your name on the online entry form counts as your agreement to all contest rules.

2. Submit your writing entry by Friday, May 8, 2026.

What You Can Enter

Your entry must be original. A person who submits an entry that is plagiarized will be disqualified from the contest.

1. Only unpublished material will be accepted. Copyright remains the property of the author.
2. Your entry can be on any topic and can be fiction, non-fiction or poetry/lyrics.
3. You can send in a maximum of 3 entries, but you can receive only one prize.
4. Your entry must be typed or handwritten very clearly, double-spaced, on 8 ½ x 11-inch paper and a maximum of 5 pages or 1200 words long.

Who Can Enter

1. This contest is open to all adults who live or work in the community of Selkirk and Area.
2. Only the author has the right to submit an entry.

How Winning Entries are Chosen

Each entry will be read by a panel of reviewers and winning entries will be chosen based on content, originality and style.

Winners and Prizes

1. All authors of winning entries will be contacted and receive a prize. Winning entries will be published on-line and may also be published in the local newspaper or displayed at a local business.
