CODE ENFORCEMENT REPORT

Code Officer Fordham reported the following: 14 inspections, 11 building permits, one After the Fact permit and attended 1 Planning Board meeting. He reported the High Street court case is postponed. The property owners have been doing a great job and have 85% of the property cleaned up.

HIGHWAY REPORT

The Brown Road drainage has been graded, seeded and completed. They started the final mowing for the season which will take approximately 3 weeks. They sealed Galen Road from Wolcott Road to the air strip, worked with the County paving North Huron Road to Slaughter Road, and poured concrete slabs for Glenmark Park as well as for the bench in front of the Town Hall.

ANIMAL CONTROL REPORT

Animal Control Officer Miller had 6 calls for loose dogs; one in Huron, one in Sodus. She took two dogs to the Humane Society and one spent the night in the Rose Town kennel.
