

*Stories from the Classroom:*


Students at the Warren-Prescott have been learning all about different biomes of the world! On a frigid Tuesday, they set out on an imaginative journey to two of the coldest biomes on Earth: the tundra and the taiga. As young explorers, they investigated the plants and animals that call these icy regions home, discovering the unique adaptations that help them survive in extreme conditions.

Along the way, students compared the two biomes and uncovered an important difference. The tundra, locked beneath a layer of permafrost, cannot support trees. In contrast, the taiga is filled with towering coniferous trees that thrive in the cold climate.

The adventure continued as students brought their learning to life through art. By illustrating the tundra and taiga in both winter and summer, they blended creativity with science, turning knowledge into colorful scenes that showed how each biome changes with the seasons.
