- Enthusiastic about mentoring and empowering youth to become confident individuals and engaged members of the community
- Able to create and implement a program with clear goals, curriculum, and lesson plans
- A thorough knowledge of acting principles and techniques for young actors including improv, classical and method acting

Experience & Education

- Must have drama or musical theatre performance experience
- Preference may be given to applicants with a degree (or equivalent) in Fine Arts, Drama, Theatre Performance or Theatre Production
- Certification in an instructor-based training program, preferably focused on children/youth and leadership, *or* equivalent proven leadership experience with children/youth of varying abilities in an educational or recreational capacity
- Previous experience directing a production would be an asset
- Experience in dance and/or choreography would be an asset

This is a contract, part-time term position beginning in January 2019 and terminating June 30, 2018 with the option to renew. Compensation will be a fixed honorarium.
