- Must have previous experience in filmmaking and videography
- Certification in a program focused on working with children and youth of varying developmental abilities, *or* equivalent proven experience in an educational or recreational capacity is an asset
- Preference may be given to applicants with an education background in Film Studies, Fine Arts, or Media Arts

This is a contract, part-time term position beginning September 2022 and terminating June 2023 with the option to renew. Hours will be most Fridays from 3:30-5:00pm. Compensation will be based on previous experience, education, and training.
