MONDAY, JANUARY 24

Read John 17—A Prayer to a Giving Father

- 1. What has the Father given to Jesus that he has given to us? (v 1-5)
- 2. Who are the people that God has given to Jesus? (v 6-12)
- 3. When are we given eternal life; now, when we are good again, end time?
- Prayer: Jesus, help us learn how to pray.

TUESDAY, JANUARY 25

Read John 18—Trials of Jesus

- 1. Why is Peter's story of the denial of Christ a blessing to us?
- 2. Does Jesus go to the cross and to his death alone? Where were all his vocal and physical supporters?
- 3. What example does Jesus give us in His reaction to being slapped across the face for a perceived insolence to the high priest?
- Prayer: Jesus, help us to shun not suffering, shame, or loss and learn to bear the cross.

WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 26

Read John 19—Crucifixion

- 1. What comfort and encouragement can Jesus' care for His mother give us when we wonder what will happen to our loved ones after we die?
- 2. Was Jesus' humiliation, pain and spiritual suffering and death enough to take away our sins? What reassurance does Jesus give us in His proclamation "It is finished"?
- 3. When Jesus comes again to judge us at the end time, will he still have the marks of crucifixion?
- Prayer: Jesus, help us learn how to die.

- 3. Why did God give us the Bible?
- Prayer: Christ is risen! He meets our eyes. Savior, teach us so to rise.

FRIDAY, JANUARY 28

Read John 21 — Jesus Loves His Disciples

- 1. Why might Jesus have called out to the disciples in the boat and addressed them as children?
- 2. How is Peter, the pastor, to love and feed Jesus' sheep?
- 3. How were most of the apostles glorified? How did Peter die?
- Prayer: Lord, show me how to be a good disciple.

SATURDAY, JANUARY 29

Read Acts 1—The Promise of the Holy Spirit

- 1. What does v1 imply about Jesus' teaching and doing? Was it over after the ascension?
- 2. What does the power of the Holy Spirit do? Is this power stronger than human power?
- 3. Were the disciples instructed to witness only to the Jews, to Israel? How far has Christ's church spread?
- Prayer: Lord Jesus, be with us here and now and send the Holy Spirit to grow Your church of grace.
